SUMMARY PUBLICATION OF CITY OF NORTHFIELD ORDINANCE NO. 1076

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING NORTHFIELD CITY CODE, CHAPTER 30 – HEALTH AND SANITATION OF THE CITY CODE RELATED TO THE REGULATION OF CANNABIS BUSINESSES, LOWER-POTENCY HEMP EDIBLE RETAILERS, AND EVENTS

Summary: Ordinance 1076 amends Northfield City Code, Chapter 30 – Health and Sanitation of the City Code by repealing and replacing Article III – Sale of Edible Cannabinoid Products with a new Article III - Regulation of Cannabis Businesses, Lower-potency Hemp Edible Retailers, and Events. The ordinance sets forth the procedure required for cannabis retail businesses and lower-potency hemp edible retailers to apply for registration with the City prior to making sales in the City. The ordinance also establishes operating standards consistent with those in State law, as well as penalties and fines in the event of violations of the ordinance. Finally, the ordinance includes the procedure cannabis event organizers must follow to apply for temporary cannabis event permits from the City in order to host a temporary cannabis event.
