1. <u>18-251</u> Discussion of Strategic Plan (2018-2022): Affordable Housing: "Develop Southbridge Property"

Community Development Director Heineman introduced this item. Housing Coordinator Atchison and Three Rivers Community Action Agency Community Development Director Leah Hall, provided information on the proposed project to develop the Southbridge Sudbdivision Property owned by the HRA. Three Rivers Community Action Agency agreed to partner with the HRA to on a new project to increase the number of affordable rental housing units at Spring Creek Townhomes. The proposed project will be located on a portion of the 11.18 acres owned by the HRA in the Southbridge Area. Hall reviewed the concept plans, costs, TIF request, request for letter of support and answered questions posed by Council.
