Project update for the Water Treatment Plant Project (WATR2023-J34).

Utilities Manager Justin Wagner provided a water treatment plant update to include an overview of why the water treatment plant is needed; update on Federal funding and water rates; water treatment plant projects; alternative routing for water treatment plant sewer discharge; project timing and next steps. City Engineer/Public Works Director David Bennett added additional information.
