Background



- Bonding Authorization Process for Street Reconstruction projects
 - Authority under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 475.58
 - Allows City Council to authorize debt for street reconstruction and overlay projects identified within an adopted 5-year capital plan
 - Council gains authority for a not-to-exceed bonding amount upon holding a
 Public Hearing, adopting a 5-year plan, and allowing for a 30-day petition
 period (so-called "Reverse Referendum")
 - Public can require the issuance of bonds be subject to referendum if a valid petition signed by voters equivalent to 5% of votes cast in last general election is filed within 30-day window

2026 - Proposed Schedule



- Council adopts SROP and sets not-to-exceed amount for general obligation bonds
 - Amount for 2026 projects only
 - 2027 to 2030 project funding needs will be addressed under separate future public hearing processes
 - Next Steps:
 - 30-day petition period closes February 5th
 - City continues project design and approvals; construction bidding
 - Bonds planned for Summer 2026 after project construction contracts are approved by council
