

SUMMARY PUBLICATION OF CITY OF NORTHFIELD ORDINANCE NO. 998

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD, MINNESOTA REPEALING ARTICLE IV OF CHAPTER 70 OF THE NORTHFIELD CITY CODE, RIGHT-OF-WAY MANAGEMENT, AND REPLACING SUCH ARTICLE IN ITS ENTIRETY WITH A NEW ARTICLE IV

Summary: An ordinance repealing the entirety of Northfield Code Chapter 70, Streets, Sidewalks and Other Public Places, Article IV, Right-of-Way Management, which regulates management of public rights-of-way, and replacing such Article in its entirety with a new Article IV, Right-of-Way Management, to read as provided in Appendix A to the ordinance, which is attached thereto and incorporated therein. The new Article includes provisions making the city ordinance consistent with the League of Minnesota Cities model right-of-way ordinance in particular for the addition of regulations governing small wireless facilities and the permitting and location thereof in the public right-of-way.
