don't use too much salt on the ice

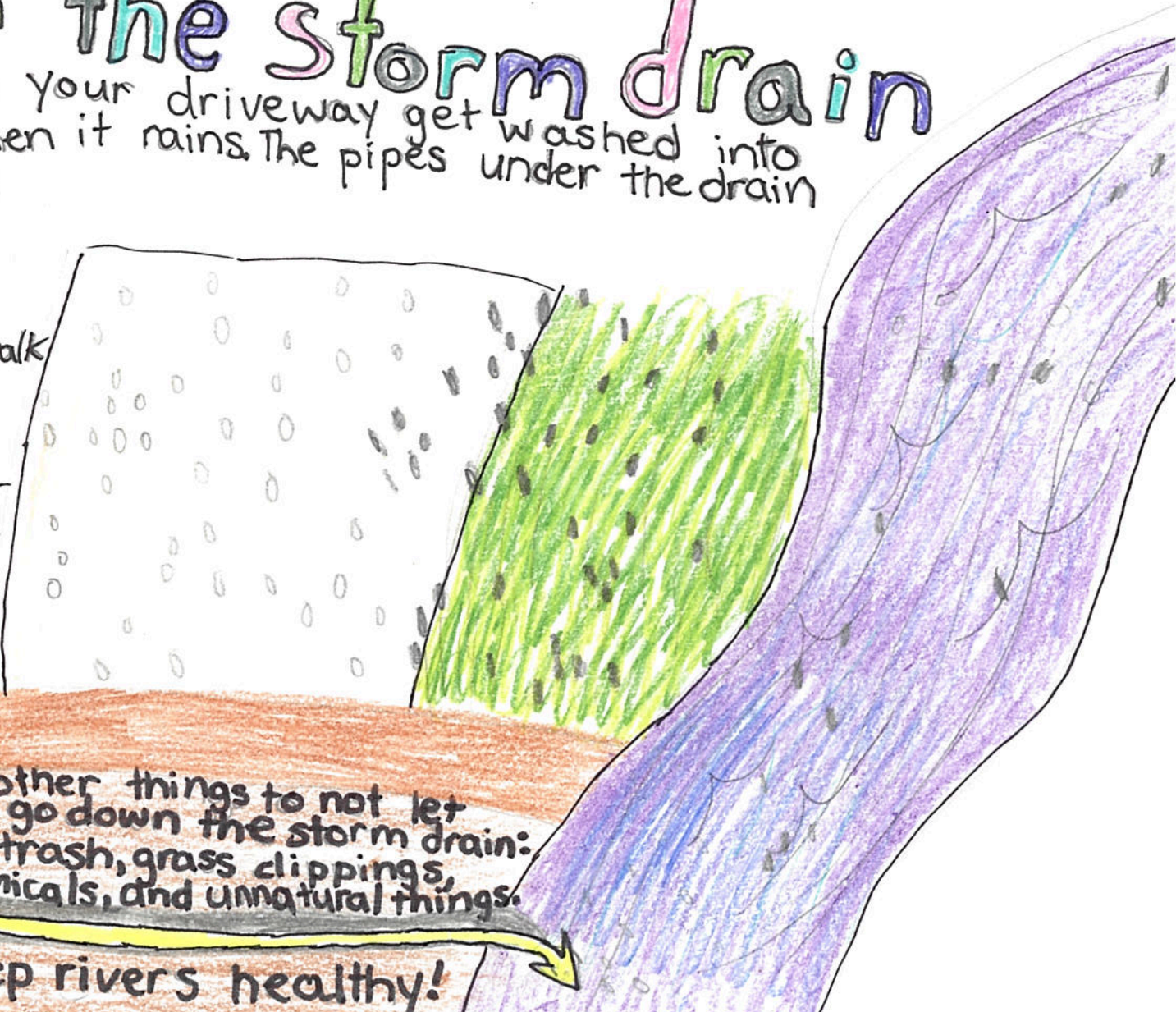

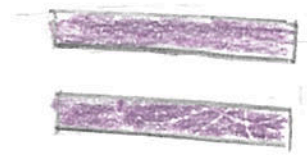
