Communications and Human Resources Director Michelle Mahowald introduced the items giving background on the Law Enforcement Labor Services (LELS) Patrol Unit Labor Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding; the International Union of Operating Engineers (IUOE) General Unit Labor Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding; the International Union of Operating Engineers (IUOE) Utility Unit Memorandum of Understanding; and the Law Enforcement Labor Services (LELS) Sergeant Unit Labor Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding. These contracts are similar and follow the wage schedule as discussed in closed session in August. These are all three-year agreements reflecting a 4% increase in 2025; a 3% increase in 2026 and a 3% increase in 2027. Brandon Fitzsimmons, Flaherty & Hood Labor Attorney, was available remotely

to answer questions.
