CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2017-103
A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING
A "COUNCIL CITY EMPLOYMENT COMMITTEE"

WHEREAS, City Ordinance Section 2-65 provides authority for the establishment of Committees of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, City Ordinance Section 2-65 (a) provides that all council committees shall be appointed by the mayor either upon his/her own initiative or upon the majority vote of all of the members of the council; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Pownell is recommending establishment of a committee related to reviewing personnel related policy agenda items that may come before the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Staff supports and recommends the establishment of a committee to pre-review or refer to committee review for personnel related policy related agenda items that may come before the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the official committee name is suggested to be "Council City Employment Committee" as it simply reflects that it is a City Council committee that is responsible for personnel related policy issues that may come before the City Council; and

WHEREAS, there is value to establish a shared understanding of the roles and responsibilities of the "Council City Employment Committee" and support the initial members work cooperatively with staff and the City Attorney's office to draft a recommendation to Council for further discussion and approval by Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THAT:

The City Council does hereby officially create a "Council City Employment Committee" to review, discuss, and advise on matters relating to policy related agenda items that may come before the City Council.
