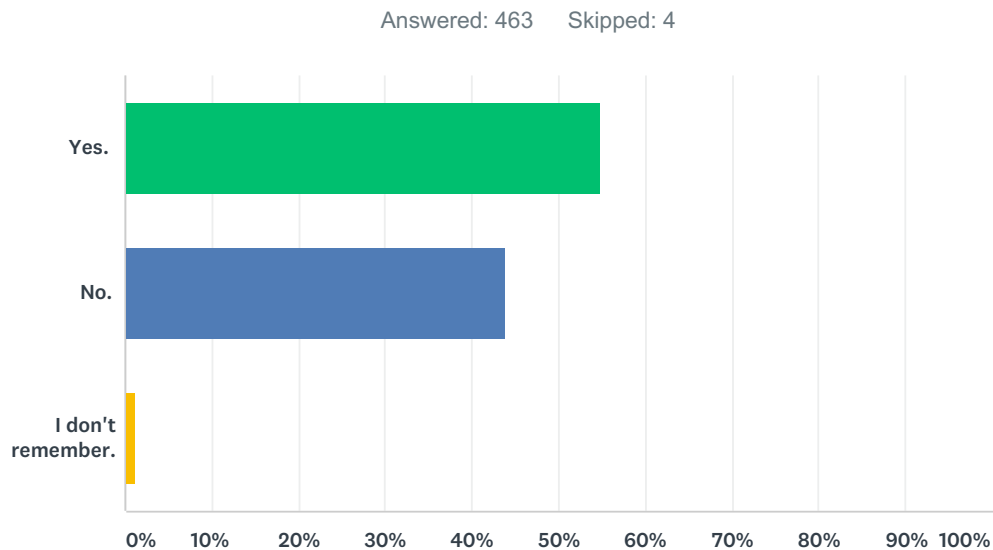


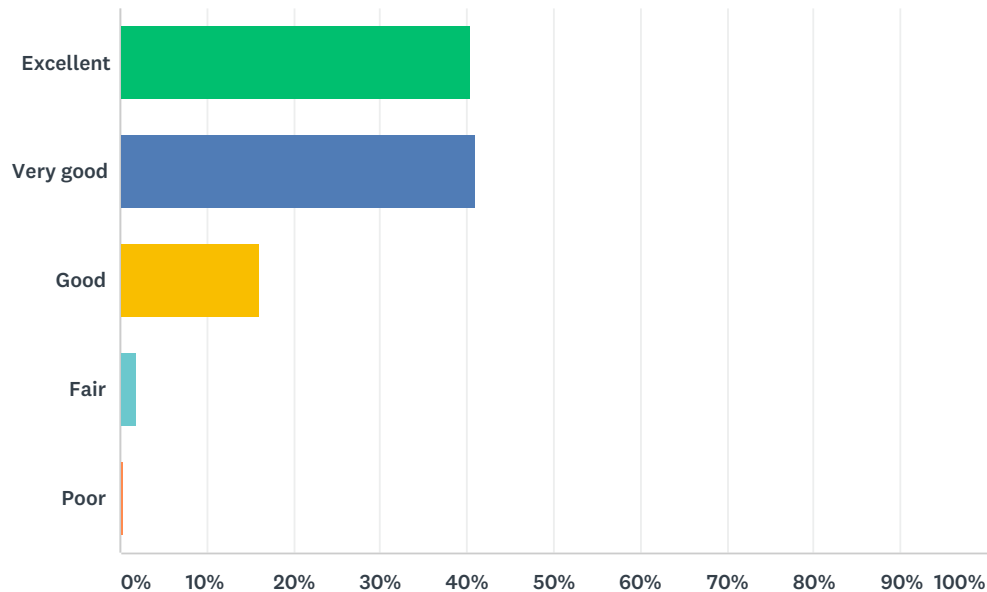
Q1 Did you receive a paper copy of this survey in the mail?

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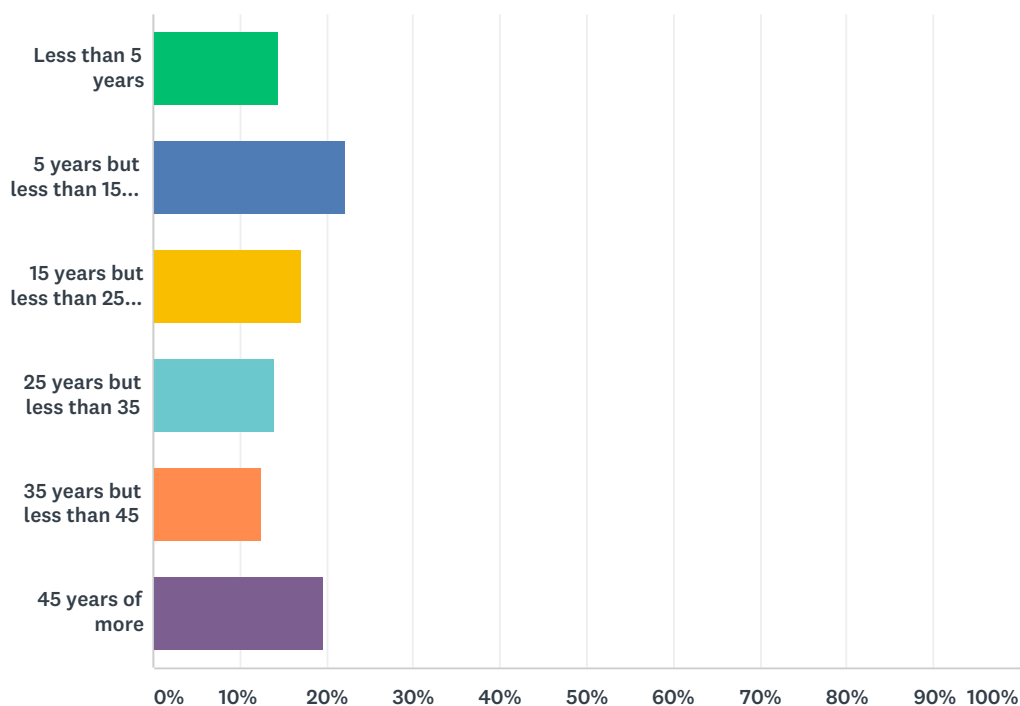

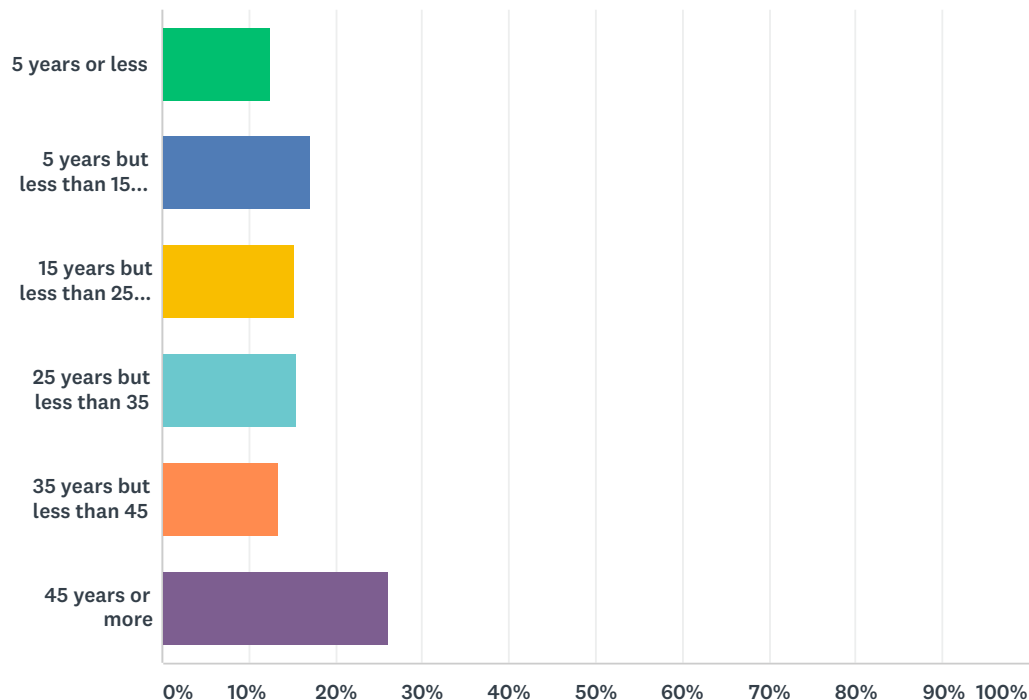

Q6 How long have you lived in your county?

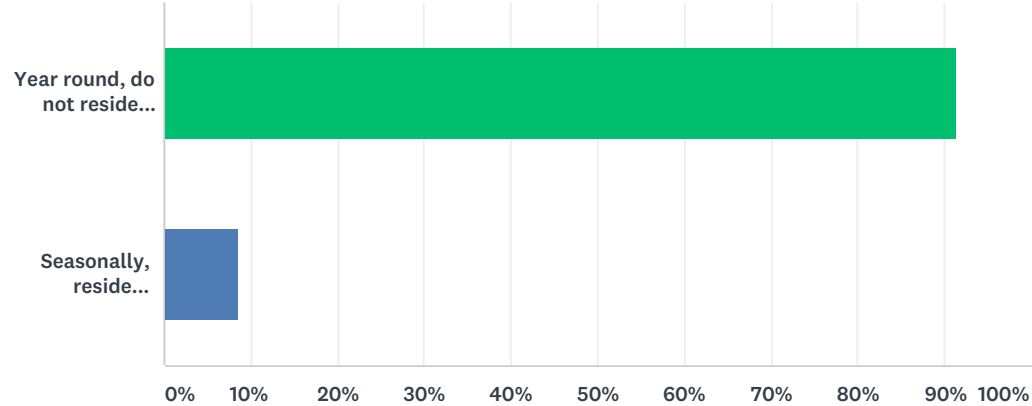

Q7 Some people reside in places outside of their state for part of the year. Which of the following describes how you reside in your state?

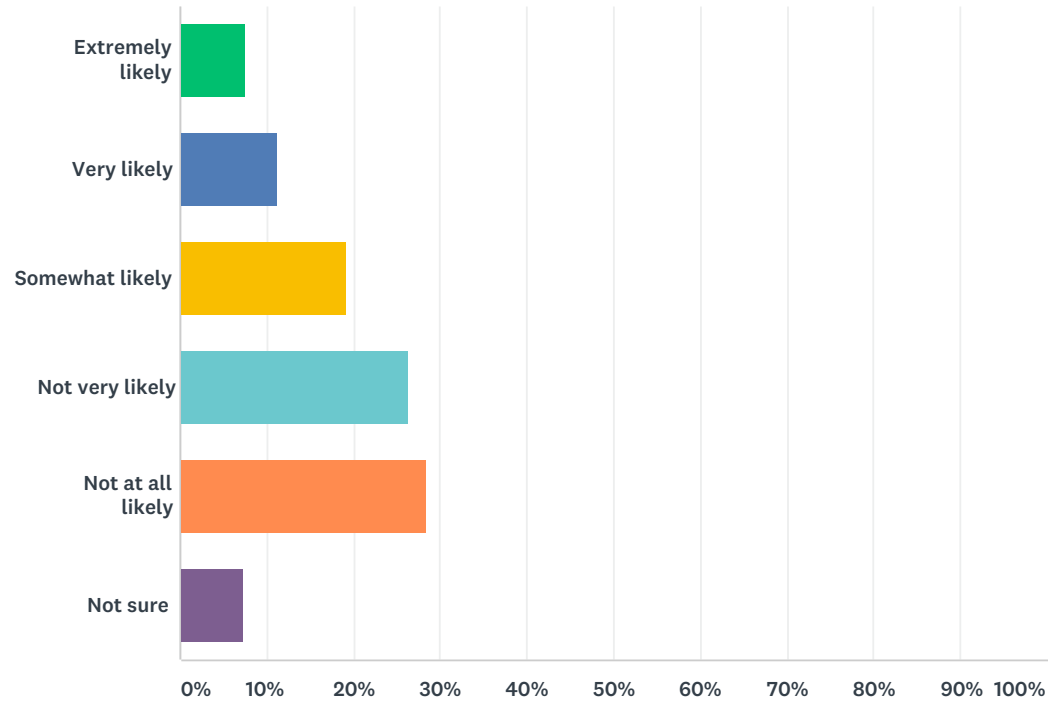

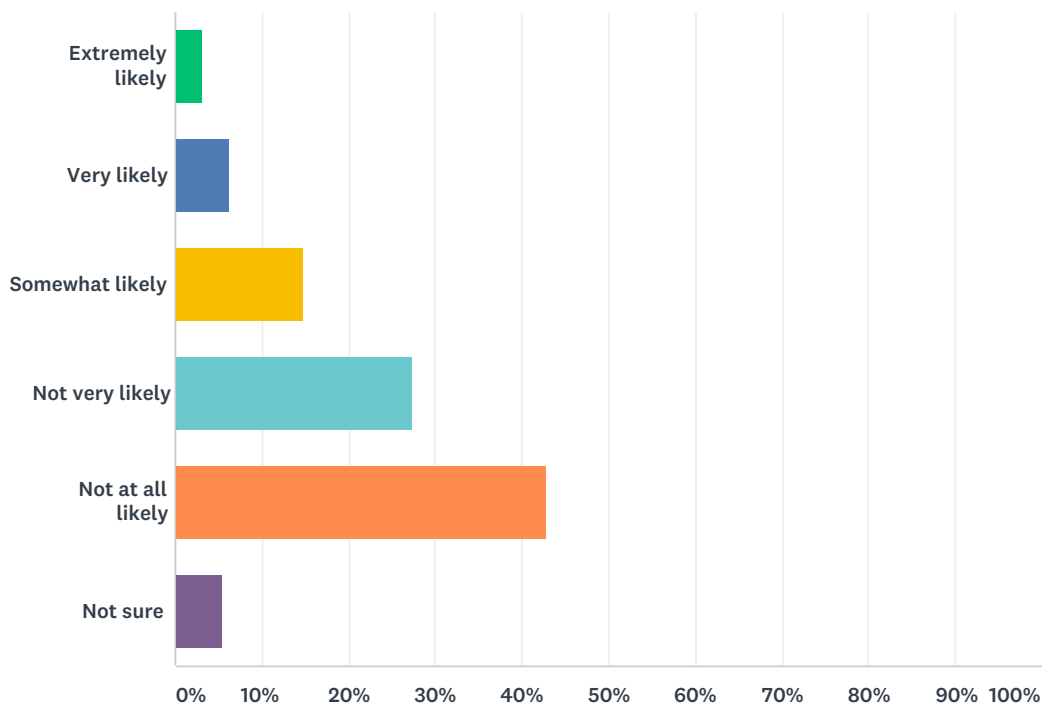

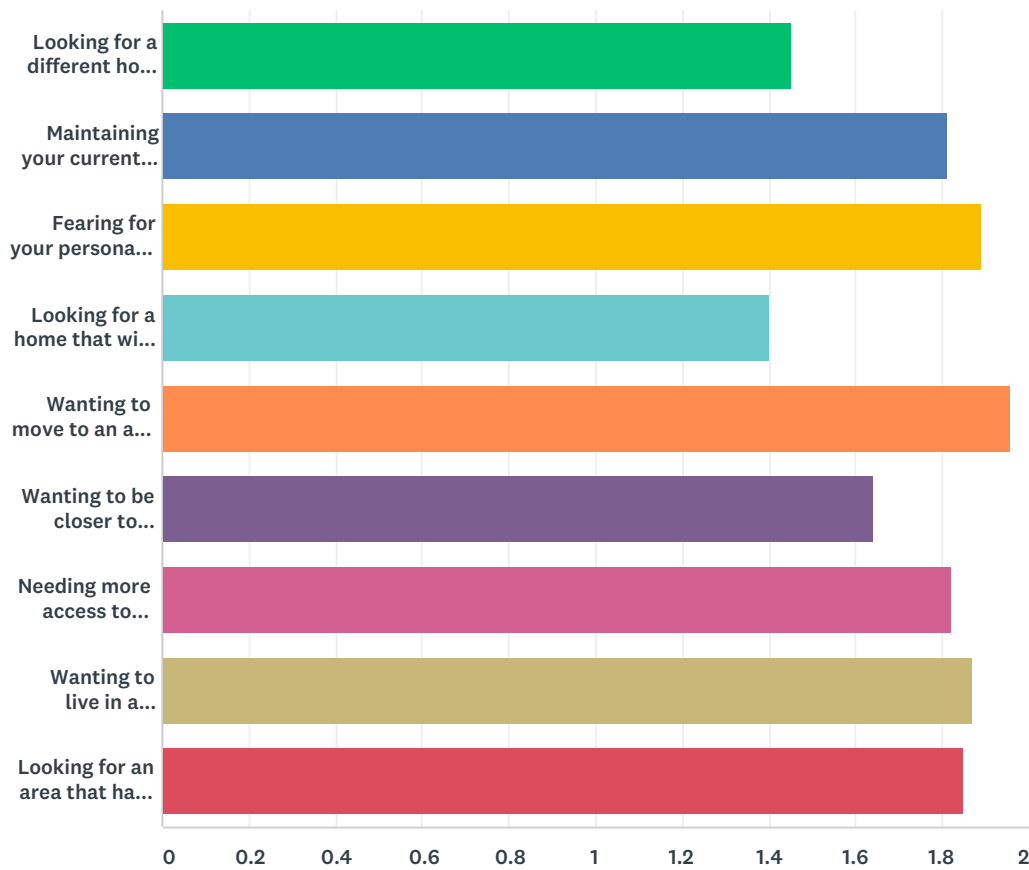

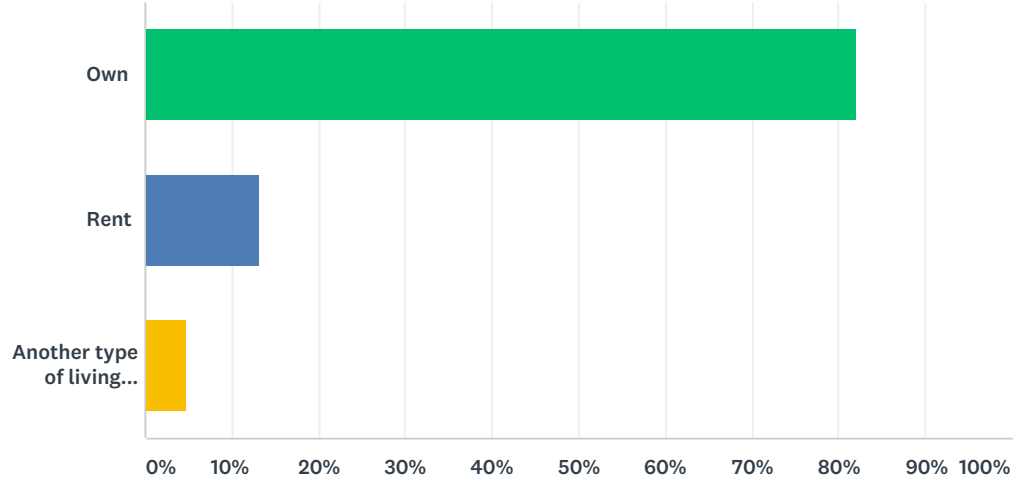

Q12 Do you own or rent your primary home - or do you have some other type of living arrangement, such as living with a family member or friend?

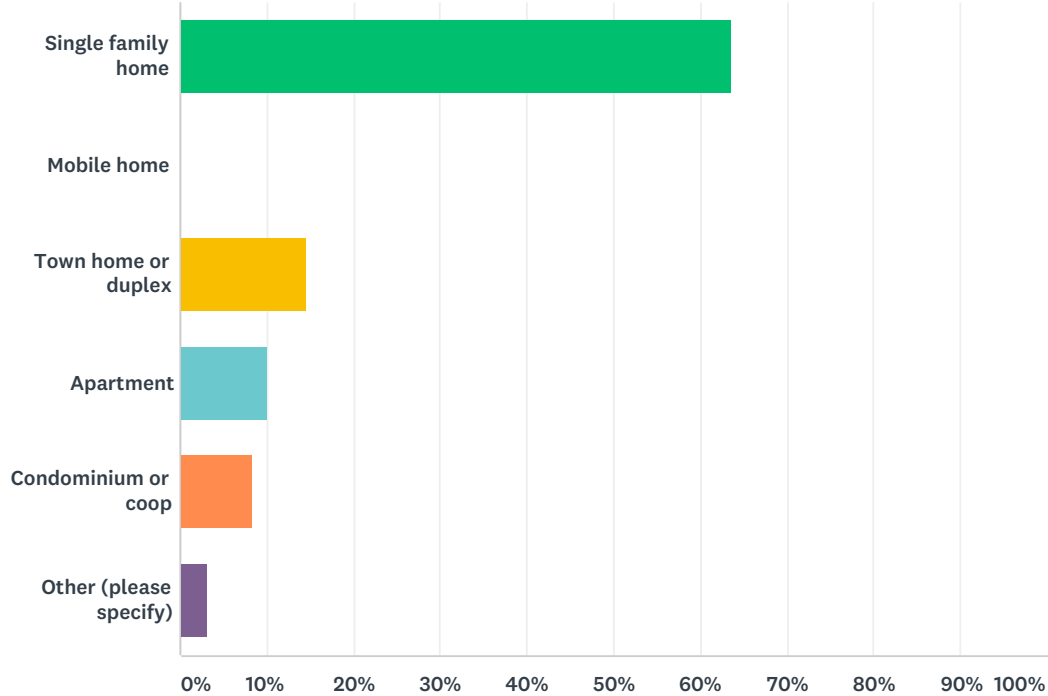

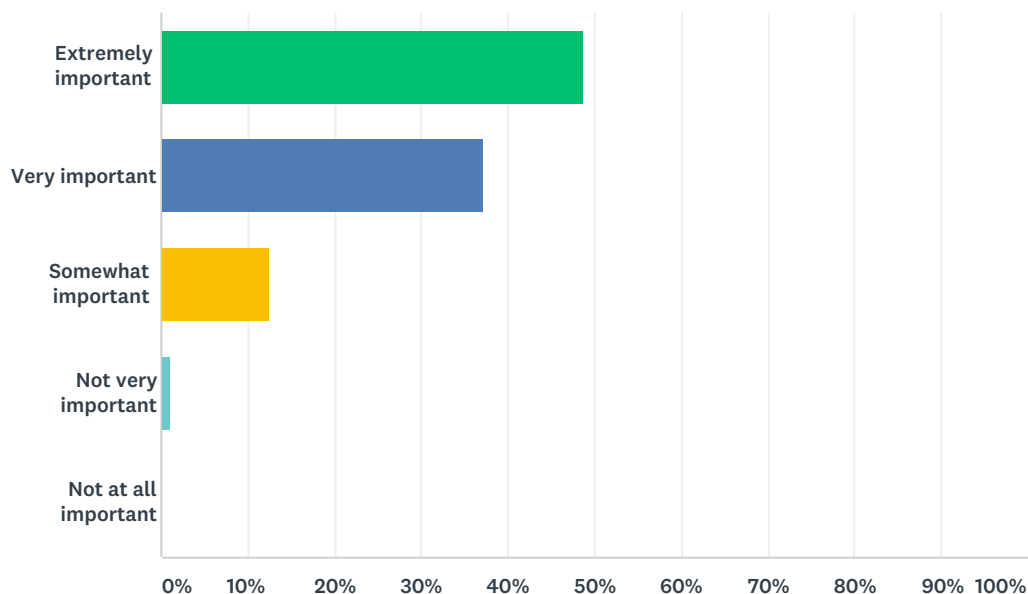

Q14 How important is it for you to be able to live independently in your own home as you age?

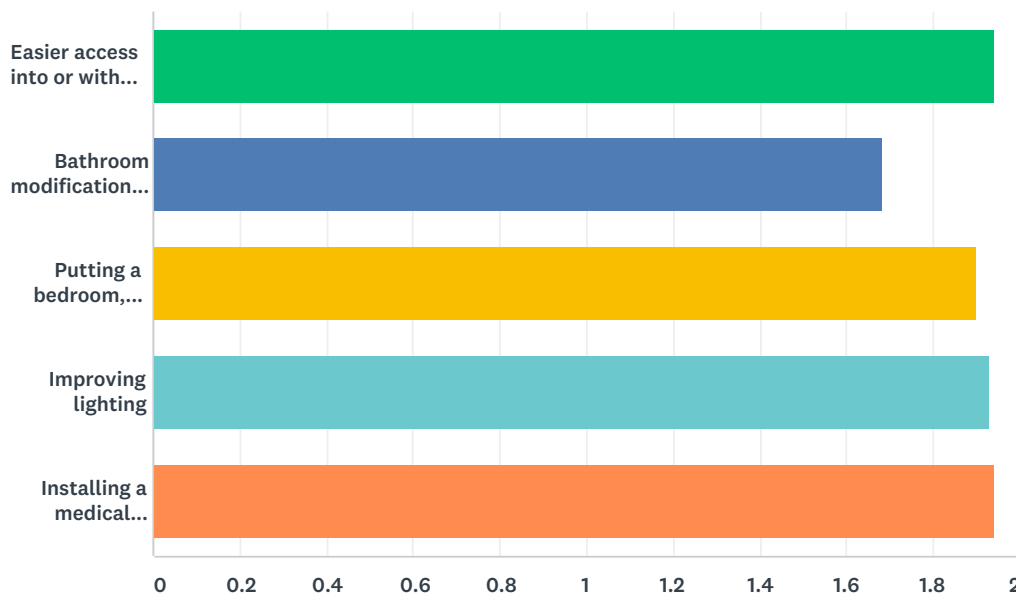

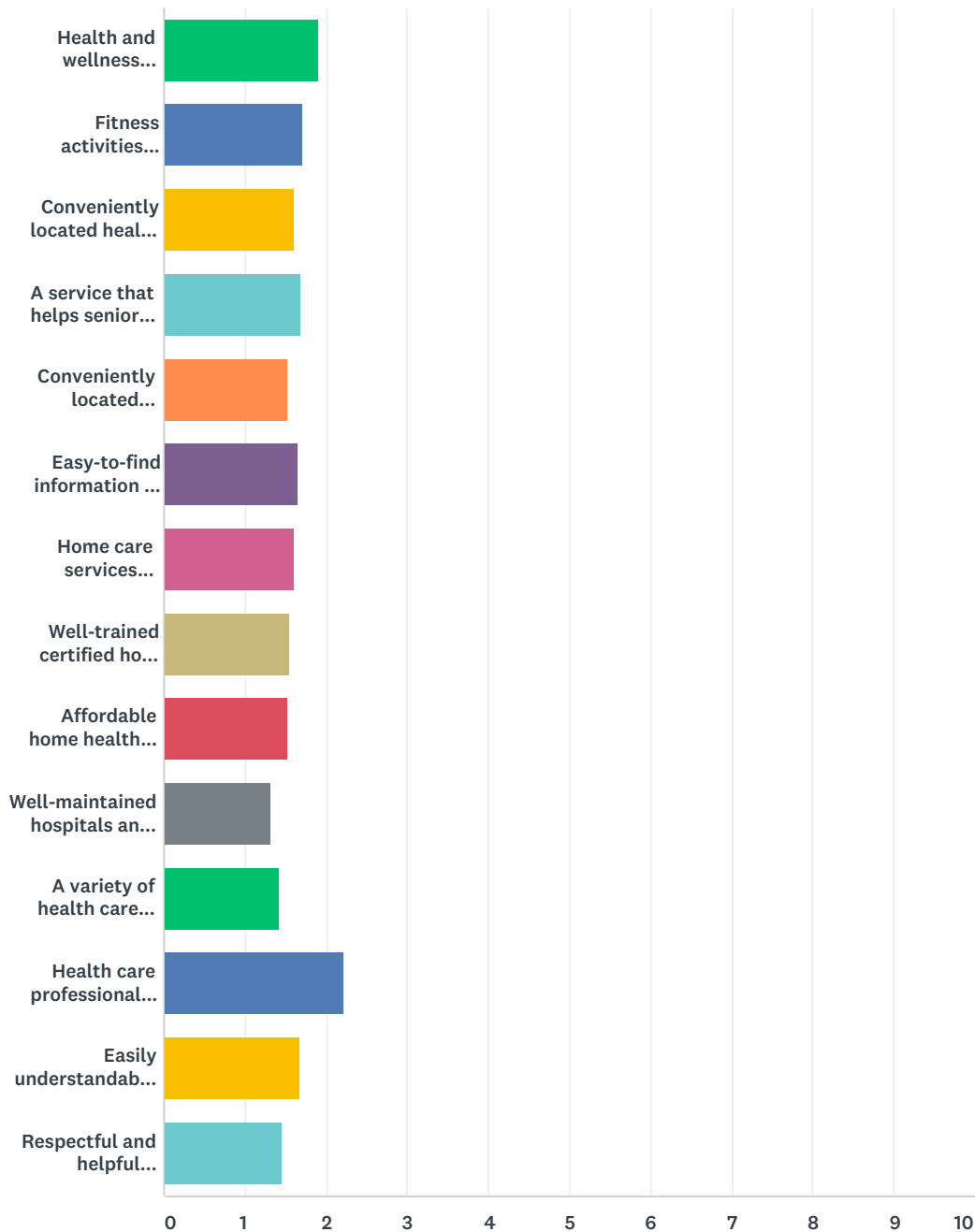

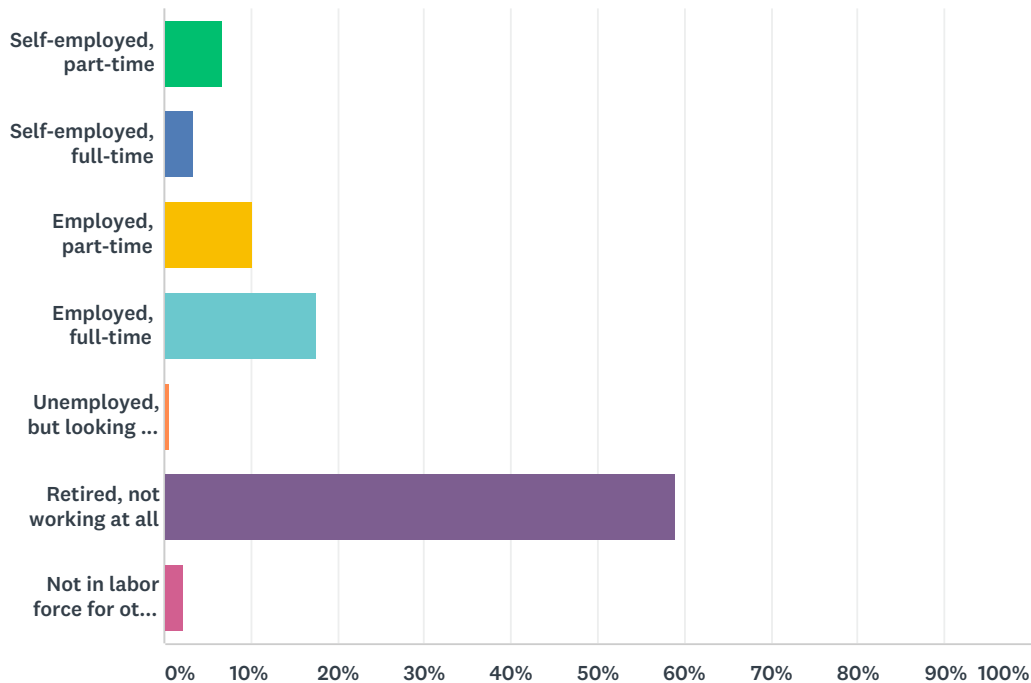

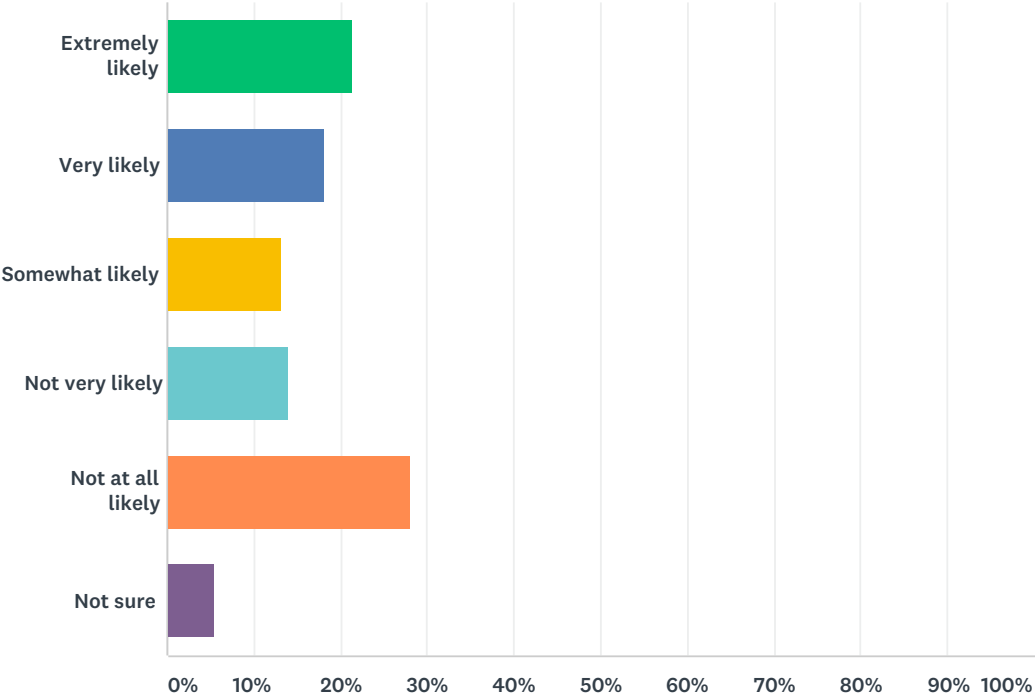

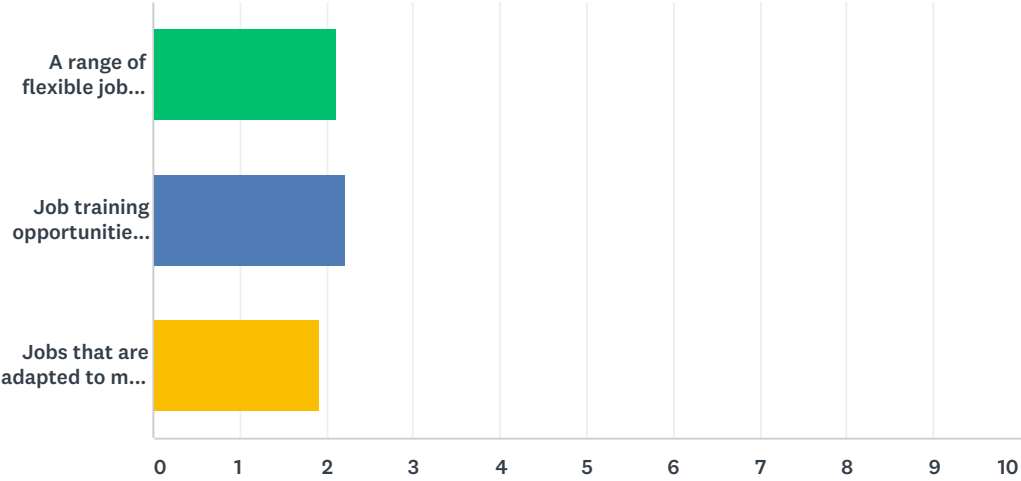

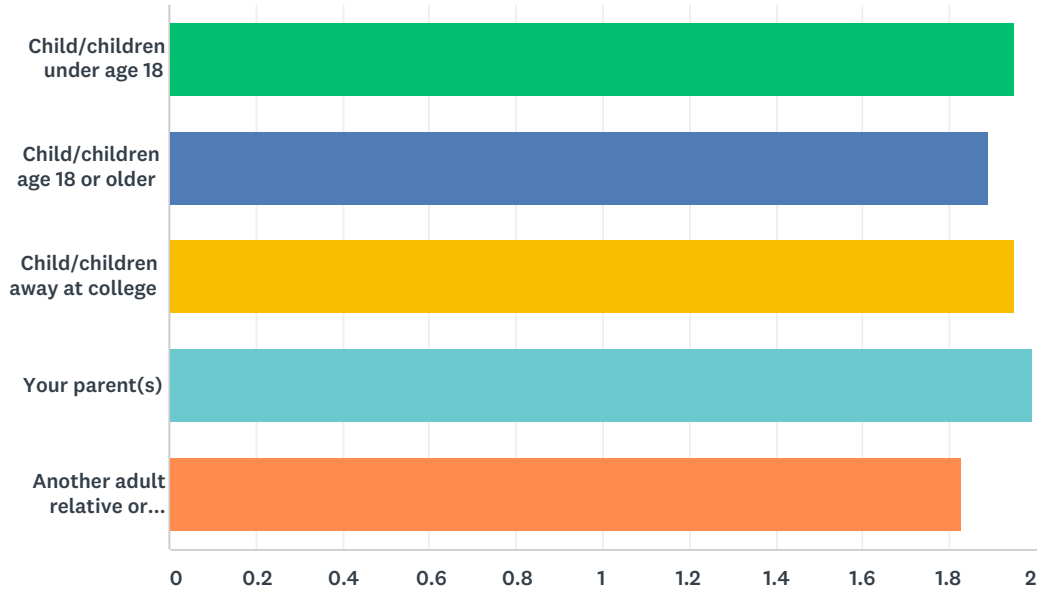

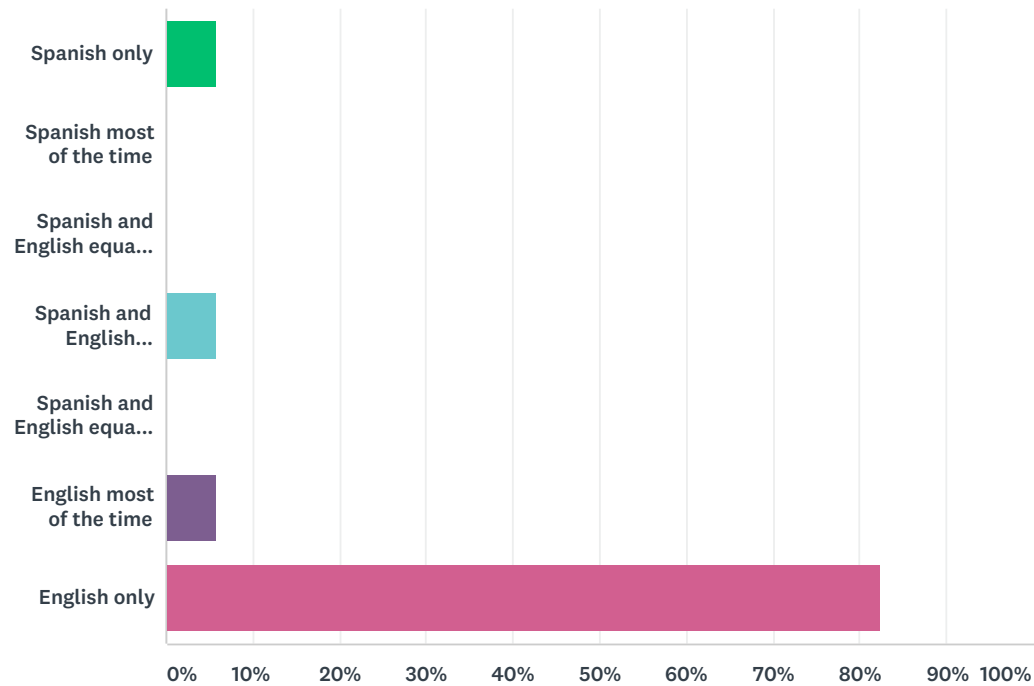

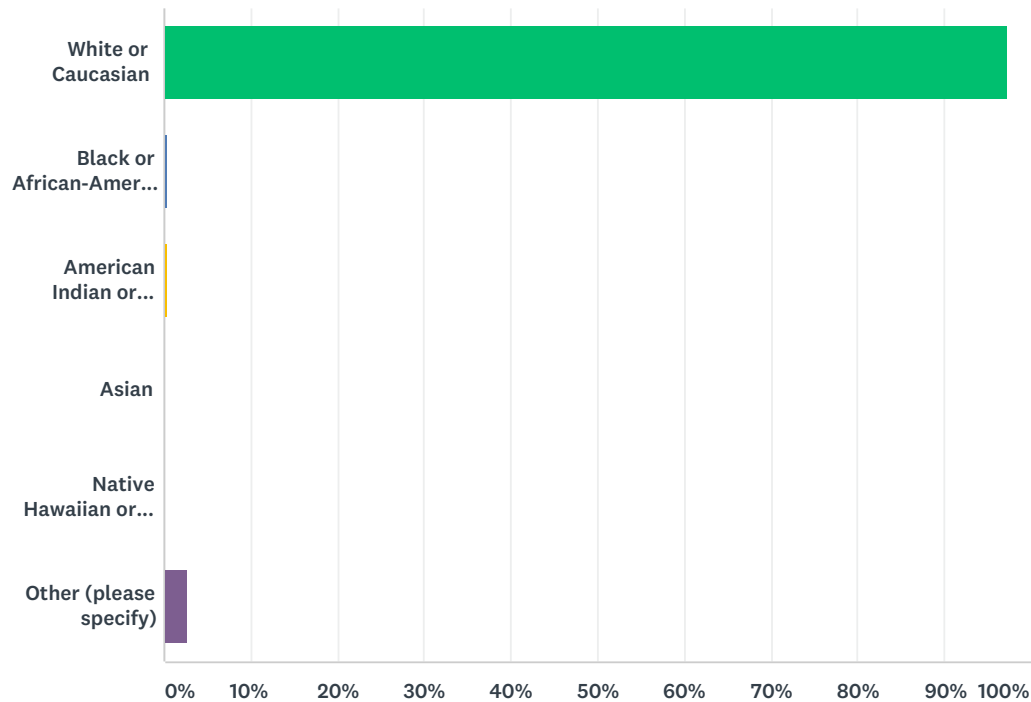

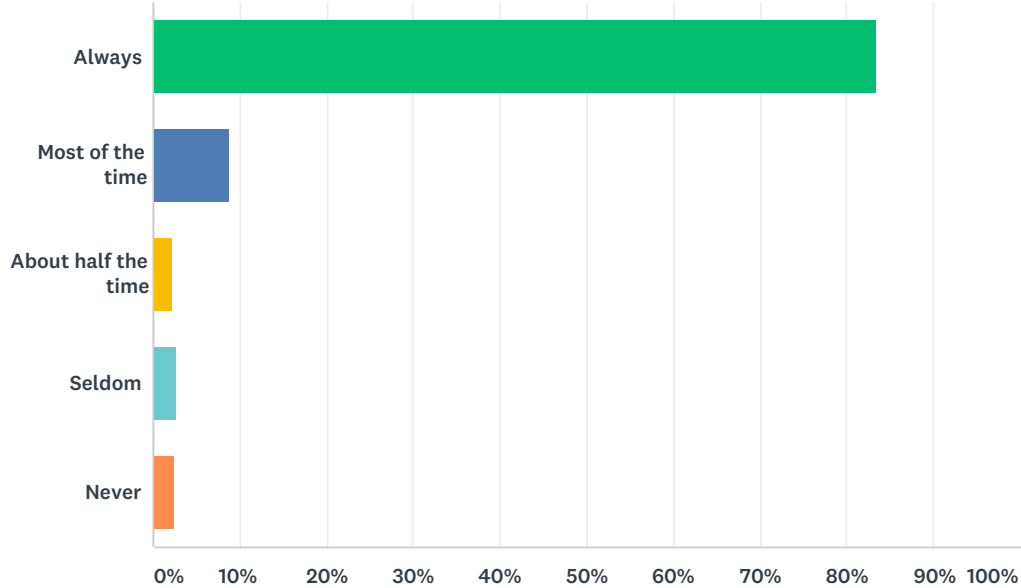

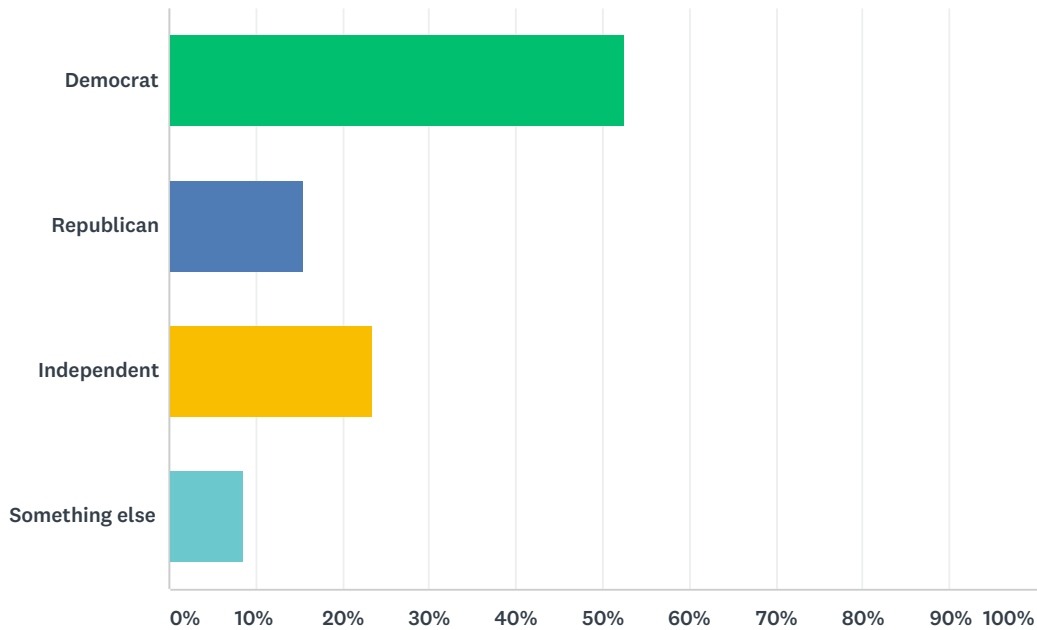

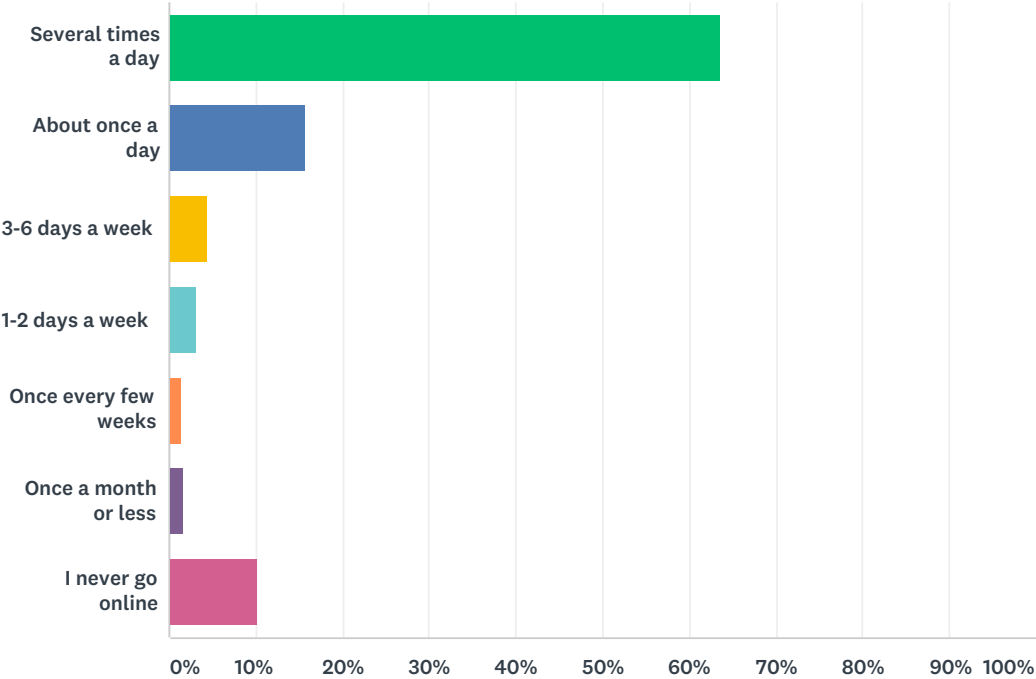

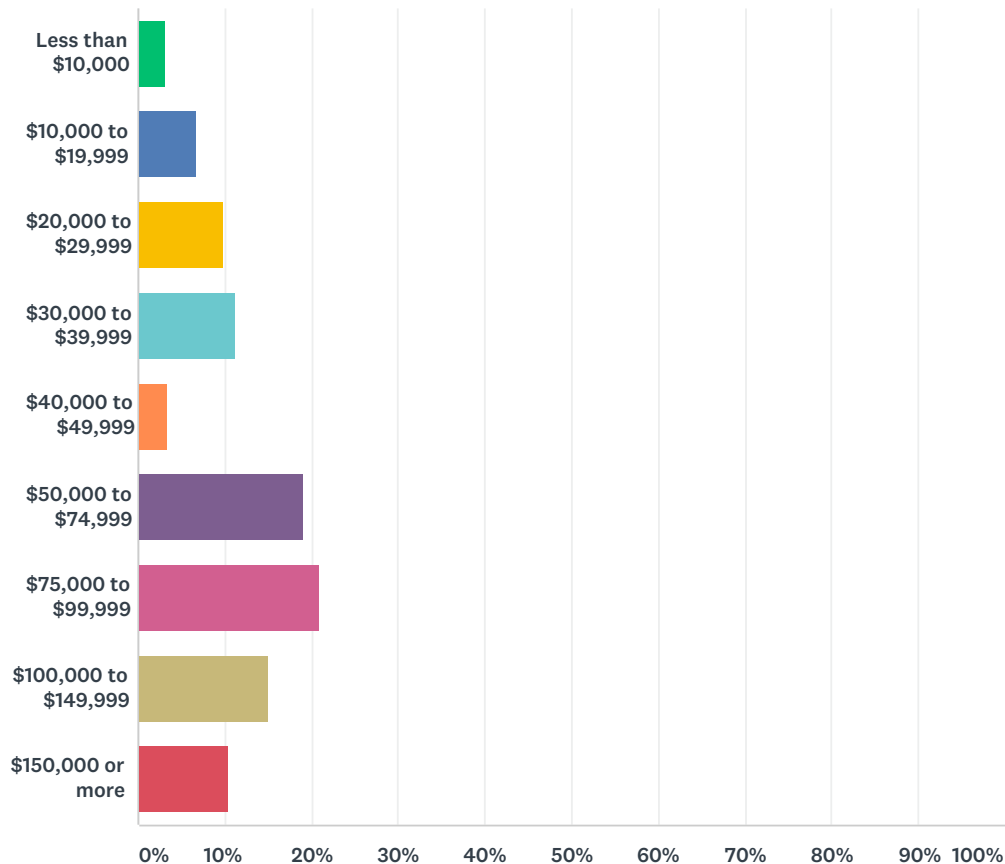
