NORTHFIELD BRIDGE SQUARE PUBLIC ART SCOPE/SPECIFICATIONS:

- potential placement for light columns are shown in pink dots (exact quantity TBD) but location is to be either on the west side of Water St. or both the east and west sides of water street (solid yellow line/dashed yellow line). Light columns should be equally spaced as applicable.

- site considerations: 1. seating areas along both east and west sides of water street, 2. views from water street + plaza down to the river, 3. ground plane plane + tree planting on either side of Water St.

- Water St. will be fully accessible.

- columns should be ~1' - 2' wide, and a minimum of 10' tall.

- structural engineer will be required to review drawings

SCHEDULE:

- SHPO to review 90% documents - end of June
- HPC Approval - August 2024
- 90% CD Review/Cost Estimate - August 2024
- Mayor/City Council Update - September 2024
- 100% CDs/Approve City Council Plans - Nov. 1 2024
- Publish Ad for BID/BID opening/Award Contract November 2024 - January 2025
- Construction - Spring 2025

Process



- ACC listens to input from community & stakeholders on Bridge Square plans as it relates to public art
- ACC provides input on Bridge Square plans
- Bring on an artist(s) at the 60% plan stage
- Overall concept approved by PARC/ACC for inclusion in 90% plans
 - 2 year grant allows for refinement of concept before installation
