ORDINANCE NO. 992

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF THE CITY CODE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD DOES ORDAIN THAT (new material is underlined; deleted material is lined out; sections and subsections which are not proposed to be amended are omitted; sections which are only proposed to be re-numbered are only set forth below as to their number and title):

SECTION 1. Northfield Code, Chapter 6 – Alcoholic Beverages, Article II. – Retailers, Division 2. – License, Section 6-60. - Special Sunday on-sale license is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 6-60. - Special Sunday on-sale license.

- (a) Required. A restaurant, club, bowling center, or hotel, as defined in this chapter, which holds an on-sale intoxicating liquor license may sell intoxicating liquor between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight on Sunday for consumption on the premises in conjunction with the sale of food if the establishment has received a special license from the city for such Sunday sales. An establishment serving intoxicating liquor on Sundays must obtain a Sunday license. The license shall be issued for a period of one year and shall expire on March 31. The fee for the license shall be established by resolution of the city council from time to time and may not exceed the statutory maximum, provided that the fee applicable to any application made after the commencement of the license year shall not be prorated.
- (b) A licensed brew pub or brewer taproom, may sell on-sale intoxicating malt liquor between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and midnight on Sunday for consumption on the premises unless prohibited by law. A brew pub or brewer taproom serving intoxicating malt liquor on Sundays must obtain a Sunday license in accordance with this section and Minn. Stat. § 340A.504. No off-sale of intoxicating malt liquor may be made on Sunday. The license shall be issued for a period of one year and shall expire on March 31. The fee for the license shall be established by resolution of the city council from time to time and may not exceed the statutory maximum, provided that the fee applicable to any application made after the commencement of the license year shall not be prorated.
- (c) A licensed cocktail room may be open and may conduct on-sale business between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and midnight on Sunday for consumption on the premises unless prohibited by law. A cocktail room serving intoxicating liquor on Sundays must obtain a Sunday license in accordance with this section and Minn. Stat. § 340A.504. The license shall be issued for a period of one year and shall expire on March 31. The fee for the license shall be established by resolution of the city council from time to time and may not exceed the statutory maximum, provided that the fee applicable to any application made after the commencement of the license year shall not be prorated.

(c)(d) Application. Application for a Sunday license shall be made to the city in the same manner and by complying with the same requirements as required for a license to sell intoxicating liquors, except for the investigation fee. (d)(e) Hours. The holder of a Sunday license may serve intoxicating liquors between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight on Sundays, and the premises shall be vacated by 12:30 a.m. on Monday. However, under special conditions, such as holidays and special celebrations, the city council may by resolution extend the serving and closing times for a particular Sunday to be the same as the maximum allowed by state law. (e)(f) Theaters. A theater licensed under section 6-57(b)(1) is not required to obtain a Sunday license but is subject to the hours established by subsection (d) above.
