Re: Proposed Ivanhoe Drive/Highland Avenue Sidewalk

Dear Property Owner:

The City of Northfield has recently completed the Pedestrian, Bike, and Trail System Master Plan update. The goal of this update was to create a safe and connected system for recreation and transportation with the City of Northfield. This update also included evaluating trails, sidewalks, and on-street facilities for walking and biking.

During the evaluation for the Master Plan Update, a sidewalk gap was identified on Ivanhoe Drive and Highland Avenue from the connecting trail to Lathrop Drive to the existing sidewalk on Manitou Street. (See map on back) Additionally, this sidewalk gap was also identified in the Safe Routes to School Plan adopted by City Council in February 2010.

During the 2019 Street Reclamation Project process, and at the April 16 Pedestrian and Bike gap discussion with City Council, they indicated bringing back for consideration the construction of a sidewalk on Highland Avenue and Ivanhoe Drive. City Council is scheduled to discuss this proposed sidewalk at the May 7, 2019 City Council meeting which begins at 6:00 p.m.


Thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation as we all embark upon this process of what we call Project Development.
