
Project Location Pavement Reclamation

Project Location Mill and Overlay




- Maple Street from Jefferson Parkway to Ford Street

- Superior Drive from Michigan Drive to Maple Street



- Evaluate improvements based on the CIP Pedestrian and Bikeway Analyzation
 - Washington Street Bikeway/Trail
 - Maple Street Trail
 - Laurel Court Trail
 - Sechler Park Trail Rehabilitation (Coordinating with MnDNR)



- 2018 Pedestrian and Bike Plan
 - Washington Street
 - Sidewalk and Bikeway








- 2022 Alta CIP Ped + Bike Analyzation
 - Woodley to Sumner
 - Option to extend Shared Use Path or On-Street Bikeway retrofit (Quick Build)
 - Sumner to Dead End
 - Recommendation changed to go to a Shared Use Path due to impacts and constraints vs a Separated Sidewalk and Bikeway
 - At March 12, 2024 Council also requested looking into a sidewalk in-lieu of a shared use path on Washington Street






Washington Street Bikeway/Trail Woodley Street to Fremont Street Two-Way Protected Bikeway (Quick Build or Shared Use Path)

Washington St. Woodley to Fremont (Existing)








Washington Street Bikeway/Trail Fremont Street to Sumner Two-Way Protected Bikeway (Quick Build or Shared Use Path)






Washington Street Bikeway/Trail Sumner Street to Ames Street Off Street Two-Way Protected Bikeway – Parking One Side







Washington Street Bikeway/Trail Sumner Street to Ames Street Two-Way Protected Bikeway – Parking Both Sides






Washington Street Bikeway/Trail Sumner Street to Ames Street Off Street Two-Way Protected Bikeway – No Parking








Washington Street Bikeway/Trail Ames to Dead End Off Street Shared Use Path









Laurel Court Trail TH 19 to Sechler Park Trail Off Street Shared Use Path

Laurel Ct. Existing TH 19







Festler Farms Trail Segment



• Staff has contacted the property owners and are working on an easement to build a connecting trail from the north dead end of Washington Street to the existing trail system to the south.



Alta Recommendations Ames Street and Washington Street Intersection Improvements



 Recommendation: marked crossing on south leg and curb extensions on the northeast and southeast corners in conjunction with bikeway and sidewalk installation.



Superior Drive and Maple Street Intersection Improvements



Recommendation: Extend the planned two-way bikeway on Maple Street south to Ford Street; raised crossing connecting trail north of Superior Drive to street-level bikeway and sidewalk on west side of Maple Street; mark crosswalk across Maple Street on south leg



Superior Drive and Michigan Street Intersection Improvements



 Recommendation: Raised crossing, curb extensions



Walking/Biking/Pedestrian Improvements

Woodley Street and Washington Street Intersection Improvements



 Recommendation: Curb extensions onto Woodley Street at all corners, marked crossings on all legs.



February 18, 2025	Approve Plans and Order Advertisement for Bids
February 26, March 5, 12, 2025	Publish Ad for Bid in Northfield News
March 20, 2025	Bid Opening – 2:00 P.M.
April 1, 2025	Accept Bids and Award Contract
May 2025	Property Owner Meetings
May – October, 2025	Construction
July 2026	Accept Improvements and Authorize Final Payment
