

Administrative Services encompasses the divisions of City Clerk's Office, Finance and Assistant City Administrator Office. The Assistant City Administrator oversees the divisions of Sustainability, Communications, Human Resources, and IT. The Sustainability Coordinator reports directly to the Assistant City Administrator. The Assistant City Administrator reports to the City Administrator.

City profile

The City of Northfield is a local government agency that provides municipal services to an estimated 21,109 residents and more than 500 businesses. The 7.6 square mile community served by the City of Northfield is primarily located in Rice County, but a portion of the city extends into Dakota County.

Northfield is a home rule charter city with a "Mayor-Council" form of government. The City Council is comprised of seven elected officials, including the mayor, who legislate policy and govern the issues related to the City of Northfield.

Of the six council positions, four are ward representatives and two are at-large positions. All terms are four years, with staggered election years. The Council is responsible for setting policy that guides the development and provision of programs and services provided to the community.

The city administrator is appointed by the seven-member City Council and oversees all City of Northfield operations.

Advancing Northfield's sustainability goals

The City of Northfield recently approved a new <u>Comprehensive Plan (2025)</u> and an updated <u>Strategic Plan (2025–2028)</u>, alongside its <u>Climate Action Plan (2019)</u>. Together, these three plans provide a strong foundation to guide the organization's sustainability efforts and set the stage for the success of the sustainability coordinator role.

The Sustainability Coordinator will play a key role in advancing the City's environmental and climate goals through a variety of high impact projects, including:

- Expanding electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure across the City and supporting EV fleet management and growth.
- Implementing the City's Zero Waste Plan and other waste reduction initiatives.
- Supporting the implementation of the Climate Action Plan and related climate resilience strategies.
- Leading or assisting with solar and geothermal projects at City facilities.
- Researching and applying for grants to support sustainability initiatives and projects
- Member of the project team for the removal of the Ames Mill Dam on the Cannon River.

This position offers the opportunity to work across departments and with community partners to drive measurable sustainability outcomes, helping Northfield meet its climate, energy, and environmental goals while supporting broader City priorities outlined in the Strategic and Comprehensive Plans.

Sustainability coordinator essential duties and responsibilities

This position is responsible for a variety of duties and responsibilities:

- Lead and coordinate City efforts related to the implementation of the Climate Action Plan.
- Serve as the Staff Liaison to the Environmental Quality Commission (EQC).
- Coordinate the implementation of the City's Zero Waste Plan, including waste reduction initiatives, recycling program enhancements, and community education campaigns.
- Develop and administer programs, initiatives, policies, and procedures aligned with the City's Climate Action goals.
- Conduct research and complete special assignments, including investigating, analyzing, and preparing reports with sound recommendations for presentation to the City Council, EQC, and other advisory bodies.
- Collaborate with internal departments to integrate sustainability and resilience strategies into City operations, capital projects, contracts, and procurement practices.
- Utilize the State of Minnesota Climate Framework for Local Governments to align city plans and actions.
- Prepare Climate Action Plan update reports and presentations for City Council, the Environmental Quality Commission (EQC), community meetings, and other public forums.
- Coordinate with community partners to advance the City's Climate Action goals.
- Monitor and report on B3 Energy Benchmarking data for all city buildings, including data entry, tracking, and utilization for performance improvement.
- Serve as the City's GreenStep Cities Coordinator, developing work plans and tracking progress to maintain or improve Northfield's recognition as a step 5 City.
- Stay informed about relevant federal, state, and local regulations as it relates to sustainability; analyze policy changes and advise staff on implications and opportunities.
- Identify, apply for, and manage grants related to environmental and sustainability initiatives.
- Integrate data analysis to identify and prioritize, supporting policy actions and demonstrate results

Minimum training and experience required to perform essential job functions

- Bachelor's degree in Environmental Studies, Sustainability, Public Administration, Urban Planning, or a related field.
- Minimum of 3 years of professional experience in sustainability, environmental policy, climate planning, or a related area.

Preferred qualifications

- Professional working proficiency in English and Spanish, including reading, speaking, listening, and writing.
- Master's degree preferred.
- Experience with data research, analysis, and ability to effectively communicate results in large and small group settings.
