11. 23-1490 Discuss Preliminary Design for Wall Street Road Improvement Project (STRT2022-A70)

See attached updated presenation. Presentation was updated to include Option 3C: No intersection change, remains All-Way Stop but the trail on the North side is placed directly behind the curb. The retaining wall moves back approximately 4 feet. The wall along Spring Creek Road will remain as it exists. Minimal impact to the Oak trees at the intersection, as the trail moves east those oaks will remain but will have root impacts. The trees along the cemetery will be removed.
