City Planner Mikayla Schmidt presented the application for a Certificate of Appropriateness for New Construction at 212 Division Street South - the former Archer House site. Chris Kennelly, representing the owners and developers of the site, Manawa LLC, and Bob Loken of ESG Architects provided additional context for the application.

Chair Evans opened the meeting to public comment:

- Alice Thomas of 418 College Street expressed concerns regarding the proposed balconies and metal screens.

- Michael Johnson of the Northfield Arts Guild at 304 Division Street praised the work of the Commission.

- Wendell Arneson 12 Fareway Drive expressed concerns regarding the proposed metal screen, mechanical screens, and glass facade.

- Nathan Hawkins, a student at Carleton College, expressed concerns about the similarity of the arched windows to those of the Nutting Block and about the proposed metal screen.

Schmidt and Loken responded to questions and comments from the Commission concerning the windows, floor plan, balconies, brick size and color, tiles, awnings, and exterior light fixtures.

A motion was made by Commissioner Allen, seconded by Commissioner Clark, to approve delaying a vote on the Certificate of Appropriateness for New Construction at 212 Division Street South - the former Archer House site until the next HPC meeting. The motion carried by the following vote:
