Living Treasure Award: No addition to report.

4X4 Gateway Corridor subcommittee (Melby): The Roundtable is interested in moving forward with Arts Town banners. They will be asking the City Council to add a new category of banner to the City's banner policy.

Convention and Visitors' Bureau (Gilbertson): The CVB did not meet in March.

Art in City Hall (Ewald): Jury met this morning, looking at submissions. A big thank you to Kathy Vizina who does amazing work, printing and organizing and communicating with the artists. Nine artists showing 18 works of art. Six of the nine have never submitted before, perhaps because the guidelines were broadened to include people who work in Northfield but do not live in town. **ACTION:** Talk to the new artists to see how they found out about it. Installing May 1st, reception on June 11th before the City Council Meeting.
