### Northfield Poet Laureate Report Summary: September 2016-May 2023

### Activities as Poet Laureate

- Wrote and read more than 25 poems for public occasions in Northfield. These include poems for City Council meetings, dedications of parks and public art, the Joseph Lee Heywood graveside ceremony (2016), Living Treasure Award ceremonies (2017-2020), State of the City Addresses (2018-2020), and Boards and Commission Recognitions events (2017-2018). One poem was included in the pre-recorded portion of the 2020 Northfield High School commencement, which was held online due to Covid-19 (link: https://npb.ci.northfield.mn.us/CablecastPublicSite/show/183?channel=1).
- Organized and hosted more than 50 poetry readings at the Northfield Public Library, Content Bookstore, Imminent Brewing, Hot Spot Music, and the Northfield Depot, including three readings featuring poetry and music (since 2015). At least half of these readings have featured local poets (Northfield and Faribault area).
- Organized and hosted a Northfield Poetry Festival (2017-2019). The festivals in 2017 and 2019 served as the capstone event for SEMAC grants in those years.
- Organized and hosted the Northfield Poetry Tour, which featured more than 30 local poets, including several reading in public for the first time (2023).
- Organized and hosted 4 juried Writers Night readings (2017-2019), including one as part of the inaugural First Friday Art Night sponsored by the Northfield Downtown Development Corporation (NDDC) and one on Resilience and Sustainability cosponsored by the City of Northfield Climate Action Plan Advisory Board. - Wrote two successful SEMAC grant applications (2017, 2019) which brought \$20,000 to the Northfield Public Library for poetry programing over two years. Funds from these grants also paid for the lectern and camera used at library events, as well as for the installation of the poem in the library atrium.
- Led poetry workshops at FiftyNorth, Northfield Arts Guild, and Northfield Public Schools.
- Led a summer poetry day camp at the Northfield Arts Guild (2017) and a National Poetry Month poetry club at the Greenvale Park Community School (April 2017).
- Collaborated with art specialist Bridget Novak on a monthly poetry group at Laura Baker Services Association, and presented on the collaboration at the 2019 LBSA Gala, which featured a short video and a chapbook of poems by LBSA clients (2019-2020).
- Organized workshops by visiting poets at Northfield High School, The Key, and FiftyNorth.
- Participated in a program on the role of art in end of life conversations, sponsored by End in Mind and hosted by Cathy Wurzer (2018).
- Collaborated with Jennifer Lompart (Northfield High School) and TruArtSpeaks (Minneapolis) on youth poetry slams in Northfield (2018, 2019).
- Collaborated with Prairie Creek Community School to create a school poem, which was engraved on wood for display in the school and set to music by St. Olaf College music students as "The Prairie Creek Song" (<u>https://youtu.be/6RyK2\_tYPWA</u>).
- Created a poem for permanent display in the atrium of the Northfield Public Library (2017).

- Facilitated the creation of a collaborative community poem for the Rivewalk Steps (2019).
- Wrote and performed a narration to accompany the Cannon Valley Regional Orchestra/Northfield Arts Guild dance studio performance of *The Nuteracker* in Northfield and Cannon Falls (2018).
- Had two poems included in the anthology Undocumented: Great Lakes Poets Laureate on Social Justice (Michigan State University Press 2019), including a poem written for the Northfield Human Rights Commission's annual Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day observance.
- Read poetry at a variety show at the Contented Cow as part of Winter Walk 2018.
- Wrote and read a poem for the Northfield Arts Guild's 2017 Art and Ale fundraiser.
- Served as a judge for the state Poetry Out Loud finals (2020-2023).
- Served as a judge for the Sidewalk Poetry Contest (2017-2020), hosted kick-off and capstone celebrations, and helped with placement of poems on new sidewalks.
- Coordinated Poem in Your Pocket Day activities, including teaching a poetry lesson in all of the sixth grade English language arts classes at Northfield Middle School (2017-2019).
- Gave a talk and read poems for a Carleton College staff luncheon (2017).
- Participated in a Prairie Creek Community School staff retreat (2017).
- Led a Sunday morning poetry discussion at Bethel Lutheran Church (2018)
- Created and maintained the Northfield Poet Laureate Facebook page (<u>https://www.facebook.com/NorthfieldPoetLaureate</u>) and website (<u>https://mynpl.org/PoetLaureate</u>).
- Organized and hosted the monthly Poetry Open Mic Evening (POME) at the Northfield Public Library (beginning in November 2022).
- Wrote and presented a Proclamation, adopted by the Northfield City Council, proclaiming April 20, 2023 "Penchant Day," in honor of Penchant (Northfield Women Poets).
- Served as a juror for the Red Wing Arts 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Poet-Artist Collaboration (2020).
  Poems featured on the cover of the 2021 and 2023 chapbooks.
- Compiled and distributed an occasional Northfield Poetry Newsletter with notice of events and publications by local poets.
- Helped organize two successful writing groups for local poets
- Wrote blurbs for the back cover of poetry books by Leslie Schultz, D.E. Green, Steve McCown, and Susan Jaret McKinstry
- Made numerous guest appearances on KYMN's ArtZany! Radio for the Imagination and wrote a guest column about the Poet Laureate position for the *Northfield News*
- Seved as an ex-officio non-voting member of the Arts and Culture Commission (2016-2020)
- Served on the public art review committee for the roundabout tunnel project (2019)
