Ord. 1061 Consider Ordinance 1061 Amending the City Code of Ethics, Establishing a Uniform Set of Procedures for Boards And Commission, and Moving and Consolidating Language Located in Various Chapters of City Code (Chapters 2, 22, 34, And 42) Related to Boards and Commissions into Chapter 2 of City Code (First Reading).

• Sec. 2-376. Membership; term.

The MYC shall consist of 18 volunteer, student voting members. Members shall be appointed from and reside within the Northfield Public School District. Members must either be enrolled and attend high school within the Northfield Public School District, or live within the geographic boundaries of the city and be enrolled and attend another high school. All appointments shall be as provided in section 2-284.
