POLICE WEEK PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on October 1, 1962, President John F. Kennedy proclaimed May 15 as National Peace Officers Memorial Day, an annual observance to honor the nation's fallen law enforcement officers as "men and women of courage, judgment and dedication;" and

WHEREAS, the calendar week in which it falls has been designated National Police Week, a time of reflection and appreciation for the ultimate sacrifices made by the exceptionally dedicated men and women of law enforcement who were killed or disabled in the line of duty; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL THAT:

The week of May 11 through May 17, 2019, is proclaimed as Police Week in Northfield, Minnesota.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, we urge area residents to honor the heroism of all law enforcement officers, especially those who have given their lives so that others might live. May we always remember their tremendous sacrifice and the loved ones they left behind.
