### **Carbon Reduction Fund**



- Established in 2021
- The fund is used to support the implementation of the Climate Action Plan
- Funding Source
  - Franchise Fee collected from Xcel Energy
  - -8% of fees collected, not to exceed \$100,000
  - Fees collected quarterly

# Revenue History



- 2021-\$59,096
- 2022-\$100,000
- 2023-\$94,459
- 2024-\$99,705

The Carbon Reduction Fund has collected \$353,260 to date.
