The ride will consist of multiple distances (25, 50, 100, 180 - 2 day). The 100 & 180 will descend into Northfield. On Sat, 8/12 a post event festival at St. Olaf consisting of live music, catering, and alcohol will take place on the campus of St. Olaf. After an overnight at St. Olaf, the riders will depart Northfield on Sunday, 8/13 for Day 2.
