Land Acknowledgment Statement

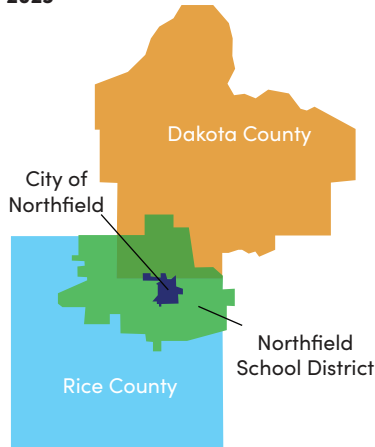
