CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2023-102
DESIGNATING CITY OF NORTHFIELD POLLING LOCATIONS

WHEREAS, it is important that citizens exercise their right to vote; and

WHEREAS, an annual resolution designating polling locations is no longer required by December 31 if there have been no changes to the designated polling locations; and

WHEREAS, the designation of polling locations shall remain in effect until different polling locations are designated; and

WHEREAS, no designation of a new or different polling location becomes effective less than 90 days prior to an election, except that a new polling location may be designated to replace a polling location that has become unavailable for use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL THAT:

The City of Northfield hereby establishes the following locations as their polling locations for all federal, state, local and special elections:

Ward 1, Precinct 1 – First United Church of Christ, 300 Union Street

Ward 1, Precinct 2 – St. Peter’s Lutheran Church, 418 Sumner Street E.

Ward 2, Precinct 1 – United Methodist Church, 1401 Maple Street S.

Ward 2, Precinct 2 – Northfield Community Resource Center, 1651 Jefferson Parkway

Ward 3, Precinct 1 – Emmaus Baptist Church, 712 Linden Street N.

Ward 3, Precinct 2 – Bethel Lutheran Church, 1321 North Avenue

Ward 4, Precinct 1 – St. John’s Lutheran Church, 500 Third Street W.

Ward 4, Precinct 2 – St. Olaf College Buntrock Commons, 1520 St. Olaf Avenue

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the polling locations shall comply with all requirements pursuant to M.S. 204B.16.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED THAT, the polling locations shall only be changed pursuant to M.S. 204B.16.
