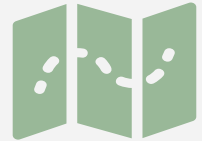

Our Project

- Propose changes/additions to current code based on targets of CAP, GreenStep Cities, other city codes, etc.
 - Offer additional info. and program ideas in appendices
- Lend next-generation environmentalist perspectives and wishes for future climate resilience

Our Findings

- **The LDC needs major amendments to make CAP goals possible**
- LDC concepts that dictate progress towards sustainability include:
 - New developments and retrofitting
 - City design and future expansion
 - Purpose of zoning districts
- Certain sections require small tweaks, others require expansions or complete overhauls
- Some CAP goals require change beyond LDC
 - City programs and incentives

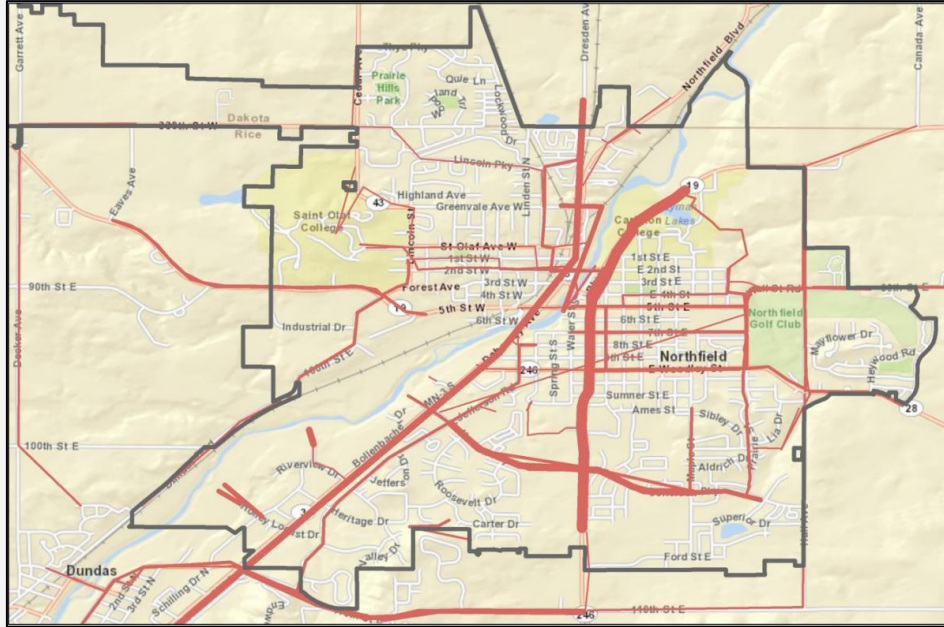
Case Study 1: Multimodal Movement

 - Form-based code

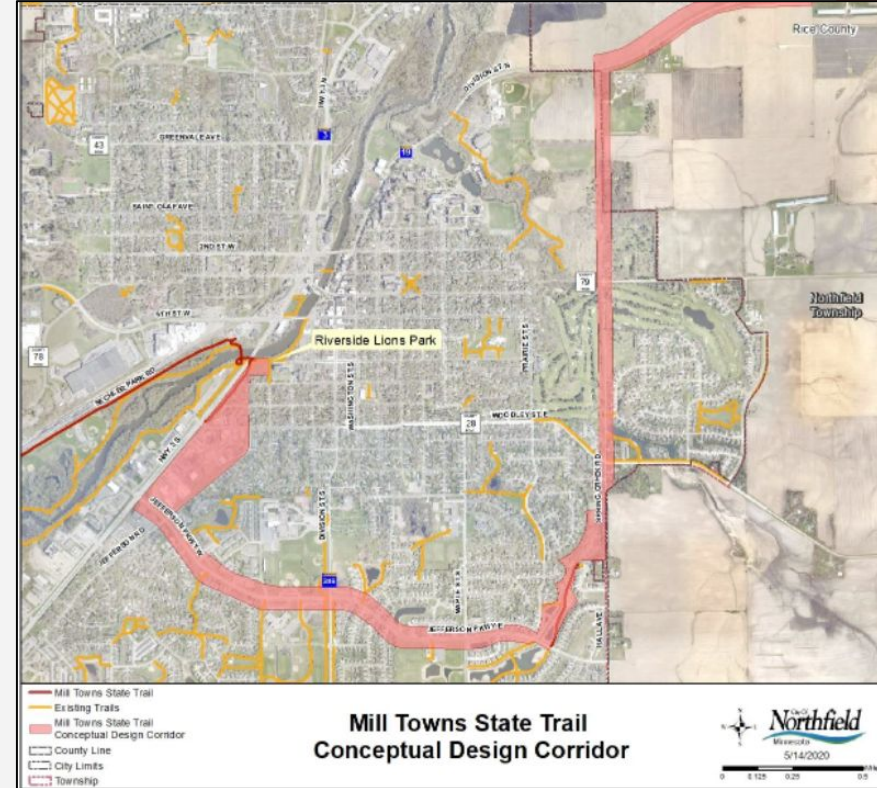

More opportunities for sustainable transportation

- Bicycle use may be improved by:
 - Adding solar canopies to power parking shelters and provide shade
 - Ensuring residents' safety while biking
 - Back-in parking
 - Clearly marking bicycle lanes



Case Study 2: Flood Mitigation

- Climate change-driven weather patterns will lead to more frequent extreme weather events, including severe storms and floods
- **Northfield faces a higher likelihood of flooding when compared to the rest of MN**

Stormwater Mitigation in Northfield



Parking

Stormwater drainage within parking lots is not adequately addressed. Multiple solutions are addressed in our report.



Landscaping

Vegetative cover and healthy shorelines are essential in preventing erosion and mitigating floods.



Stormwater Infrastructure

GreenStep Cities Best Practices include many pieces of stormwater infrastructure that could be implemented in Northfield, including smart sewer systems, retention ponds, and microgrids.

Annexation Agreements

- **Neighboring townships and community members under Northfield's protection will also be affected by increased flooding**
- Annexation agreements are the only legal contracts between Northfield and the townships
- Northfield has a responsibility toward helping these communities
- Incorporation of flood/ stormwater mitigation planning into annexation agreements → cooperation is key
