- Marlena Myles and John Sterner are co-creating the final proposal for public art for Bridge Square to present to the PARC on June 12th.
- Laura Kubick with KCI conservation cleaned the graffiti off Harvest and has completed an assessment of the maintenance and conservation needs of the permanent artwork in Bridge Square. The Anniversary Fountain sculpture by Ray Jacobsen has significant restoration needs and the work will likely be completed along with the Bridge Square renovation. The Civil War monument and Harvest will receive maintenance as well.
- We will have 4 new youth members starting in September. They are being asked to attend the August meeting but will not begin official duties until September. They are:
