**Purpose** To comply with Northfield Minnesota City Code and Northfield City Charter.

**Policy** The Chief Operating Officer and city employees will make the active law of the City

readily accessible to all citizens and will be responsible for the day-to-day administration

of City affairs and the delivery of services.

Chief Operating Officer

The Chief Operating Officer for the City of Northfield is the City Administrator. The City Administrator is responsible to, and the main staff contact with, the Northfield City Council, which sets policy for the City.

The City Administrator operates under rules established by the Northfield City Charter, the Northfield City Code, and direction given by the Northfield City Council.

The City Administrator is responsible for all the day-to-day activities of City government and all employees of the City.

The City Administrator may appoint and remove, subject to the approval of a majority of the members of the Council, all department directors. Department directors are those employees that report directly to the City Administrator.

The City Administrator may appoint and remove all other employees.

The City Administrator may delegate responsibilities and establish rules of operation not otherwise covered by the City Charter, City Code (ordinances) or Council direction.

**Employees** An employee of the City of Northfield is hired for a wage or fixed payment in exchange

for personal services and does not provide the services as part of an independent business.
