

Recreation Report June 2024



Arena Roll: Community Ed had its most successful event in four years. A total of 338 participants registered for the Arena Roll at the ice arena this year. There were 146 people in attendance on the second night of the program!



Soccer: Each elementary school has concluded their soccer programs this spring. A combined 38 participants from the Community Ed and Youth Enrichment League programs received instruction in basic soccer skills.



Indoor Tennis: A total of 65 tennis players enrolled in our fairly new indoor tennis program this spring. Each elementary school had a program for beginners and intermediate players after school. Instructors used a variety of mediums to engage students in learning tennis in both unique and traditional ways.



Swimming Lessons: Due to low interest in instruction, the April and May sessions were combined. 36 children were able to enhance their swim skills over the course of the two-week session. HS swim team members, along with a park board member, and a volunteer helped to teach the lessons and ensure we did not turn anyone away!
