Subject: Park Update

Archery Range

Old archery range site has been cleared of all items. Storage containers have been moved to
new site along with large arrow. Targets and other items will be stored at Street Shop while the
berm is built and ground is established. City crews are currently building berm, contractor has
moved in 10 trees that were set to be cut down due to the utility extension project. Staff will try to
get ground worked up and dormant seed before winter.







General Parks:

- Sechler Park field maintenance project has been completed. NYBA applied for and received a donation from Metro Baseball Association for \$36500. Items completed with donation.
 - Field Maintenance on Wells Fargo and Post Consumer Brands

 - -Edge entire infield and basepath area
 -Resod perimeter of home plat and pitching area
 - -Reset base anchors
 - -Add ag lime and laser grade infield basepath
 - -Remove Pitching Mounds
 - -Purchase artificial pitching mounds
 - -Replace batting cage nets





- Sechler Park has had multiple break-ins over the last few weeks. Staff had door contractors look at repairs to damaged doors and checked on any accessories that can be added to help protect secure areas.
- Mill Towns State Trail the underpass has been set on TH-19, crews will now begin work from the Canada Ave bridge and work towards Woodley & Spring Creek Rd
- Streets and Parks staff have winterized all sprinkler systems and park pavilions.
- Staff is working on end of season inspections on parks and playground equipment.
