

Mayor's Proclamation Declaring A Local Emergency
(under Minn. Stat. §§ 12.29 and 12.37)

WHEREAS, the Mayor of City of Northfield (City) finds that the following situation exists:

Dangerous flooding conditions now exist and are likely to persist in and around the City of Northfield creating an imminent danger to persons and property.

WHEREAS, the Mayor finds that the situation is sudden and unforeseen and could not have been anticipated;

WHEREAS, the Mayor finds that conditions in the City have worsened considerably as a result of the flood situation;

WHEREAS, the Mayor finds that this situation threatens the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the community;

WHEREAS, the Mayor finds that the situation has resulted and may result in catastrophic loss to property and the environment and will cause additional loss and destruction of property and the environment if not immediately addressed;

WHEREAS, the Mayor finds that traditional sources of relief are not able to repair or prevent the injury or loss.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor declares this situation to be a local emergency effective at 12:15pm p.m. on September 22, 2016.

This declaration of a local emergency will invoke the City's emergency plan and all powers granted to the Mayor and City in accordance with state law, Charter and City Code.
