CITY OF NORTHFIELD, MN CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2025-059 REQUESTING MINNESOTA STATE CAPITAL INVESTMENT BONDS FOR WATER TREATMENT PLANT IN THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD WITH PRIORITY #1 DESIGNATION

WHEREAS, the City of Northfield provides water service within city limits; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Department of Health adopted a health risk limit of 0.10mg/L of Manganese for infants that the City of Northfield's drinking water is exceeding; and

WHEREAS, a drinking water treatment plant with gravity filtration will lower the manganese level in the drinking water below the Minnesota Department of Health's health risk limit to provide safe drinking water to all residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Northfield understands that it will be responsible for all costs not covered by these, or similar grants, or may be required to offer a match amount; and

WHEREAS, the City of Northfield will operate and maintain the drinking water treatment plant for the lifetime of the facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL THAT:

The Northfield City Council hereby requests State capital investment bonds proceeds for a grant to the City of Northfield in the amount of \$32 Million which is half of the estimated cost of the \$64 Million Drinking Water Treatment Plant for preparation of the site, including environmental remediation: predesign, design, construction, furnishing and equipment for a Drinking Water Treatment Plant.
