WHEREAS, *The Wandering House* is a mobile audio-recording studio, fashioned out of a retrofitted ice fishing house, that will collect Northfielders' oral testimonies during the summer and fall of 2019; and

WHEREAS, Community members will be asked to share their ideas and ideals of home and how immigration, and the influx of people perceived as different, have affected these notions. Participants will also be invited to share their own family stories of immigration; and

WHEREAS, Cecilia Cornejo Sotelo is seeking grant funding to make *The Wandering House* a reality; and

WHEREAS, the Northfield Human Rights Commission approved their support for Cornejo Sotelo's *The Wandering House* at their meeting on February 8, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THAT:
