HIGHLIGHTS

- ✓ Summer recreation programs kicked off with 973 people enrolled in 79 classes in the first week.
- ✓ 37 staff have been hired to carry out 20 in-house programs this summer. Additionally, 36 outside organizations & coaches have been contracted to run various camps and programs.
- ✓ 214 private lessons have been scheduled in aquatics, tennis, basketball, and golf thus far. Private tennis, basketball, and golf are new this summer.
- ✓ There are 17 teams playing in our Adult Softball League, one fewer than last summer.
- ✓ Community Ed Summer Intern, Amelia Rosenhamer, has been highlighting a program of the week on social media, and also organizes the little league players of the week, among much more!
