



Recreation Report December 2024



Age-Friendly Pickleball began on Sunday, November 3rd, and will run throughout the school year at Bridgewater Elementary (beginners), and Northfield High School (advanced). This program is of no cost due to the support of Age-Friendly Northfield. All ages are welcome at both locations for practicing, or playing games.



Adult Basketball League / Pick-Up Basketball: The Sunday night league has eleven teams, and plays at Northfield High School at 6, 7:10, and 8:20 pm. Pick-up basketball brings in roughly 10 - 25 players per night and is held at the Northfield Middle School on Wednesday evenings, where self-officiated pick-up games are played.



Boxing is held at the Northfield Community Education center on Thursday evenings. There are a total of eleven participants, up 8 from last session. This program is for ages 10 and up and runs for five consecutive weeks from 6 - 7 pm.



Flag Football: This program concluded in October, and had close to 200 participants. St. Olaf and Carleton College football players coached a total of 20 teams on Mondays & Thursdays at Sechler Park. Thank you to city staff who always had the fields ready for our program. Parents commented that this program is well-run and is something their child talks about year-round!



Futsal - Our adult indoor soccer program was new as of last year, and continues to attract adult participants. We are now offering a program for grades 8 - 12. These programs take place on Sundays at the Northfield Middle School (4 - 5:45 pm, grades 8 - 12 / 6 - 8 pm, Adults). Cost is \$3 to drop-in, or \$55 for the session.
