If you desire to make oral comments to the City Council, please unmute your device and turn on your camera (if applicable) and the chair will call upon you to speak. Persons must give their name and address.

• eComment – Comment on agenda items by using the eComment (electronic comment) system no later than 4 pm the day of the meeting. Once the City Council agenda is published, the eComment link will be active.
