There was a large and enthusiastic audience at Content on the evening of November 14 for a reading by Michael Bazzett, Michael Kleber-Diggs, and Lee Colin Thomas. It was the first poetry reading at Content since January 2020.

I was invited to read and discuss two of my poems via Zoom with a Poetry and Faith group based in Ann Arbor, Michigan. The reading and discussion took place on Sunday, November 21.
