CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2022-007  
2021-2022 MNDOT TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE SOLICITATION  
SPONSORSHIP APPROVAL

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Department of Transportation has solicited applications for funding of the Transportation Alternatives (TA) Program; and,

WHEREAS, The Transportation Alternatives Solicitation is a competitive grant opportunity for local communities and regional agencies to fund projects for pedestrian and bicycle facilities, historic preservation, Safe Routes to School and more, and,

WHEREAS, Minnesota will be soliciting projects for approximately \$6.2 million in available grant funding across the state where the total is sub-targeted to the seven area transportation partnerships; and,

WHEREAS, MnDOT District 6, which Northfield is part of, will have \$1,200,000 available in 2026; and,

WHEREAS, MnDOT is scheduled to complete a mill and overlay project on TH 19 from TH 3 to New Prague during the 2026 Construction Season; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Northfield will propose a trail on TH 19 from Armstrong Road to Decker Avenue in conjunction with the MnDOT TH 19 Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL THAT:

The City of Northfield agrees to act as sponsoring agency for the project identified as TH 19 Trail Improvement seeking Transportation Alternatives Funding and has reviewed and approved the project as proposed. Sponsorship includes a willingness to secure and guarantee the local share of costs associated with this project and responsibility for seeing this project through to its completion, with compliance of all applicable laws, rules and regulations.
