Draper reported that bids were approved by City Council - approx. \$50,000 will go into the 1% fund - will be looking at fall 2024 for a project. Also there is an opportunity for art in Babcock Park because they are remodeling the bathrooms. Perhaps a mural. She is working with the Friends of Downtown, who have some funds, and are interested in creating a Hispanic Heritage banner. They will be putting out a call for artists soon. ACC will be forming a PARC for this.

Draper would like the commission to look at ways to encouraging developers to participate in the 1% for the arts program. By including art in their projects they would be adding value to the project and the community. Draper is asking if the commissioners would be willing to help formulate this process by looking at other cities and how they do this. Draper will bring the idea back at another date.
