They are proposing to use the area along Water Street starting at the north side of the post office back entrance so not to block that. As well as Bridge Square between division and Water Street including Bridge Square Street from Division Street up to the Bridge. It is expected that 300 people will attend the event.

This will include participation from local vendors, small business and downtown businesses alike. Expected attendance is 600 people per night.
The Heywood Ride	Central Park/Sechler Park for Riders to Camp	05/19/2023-05/20/2023		\$555	The Heywood Ride is a community driven bicycle ride on the rural roads of Rice County and Goodhue County, though most riders will be in Rice County. The event starts and finishes in Northfield at Central Park and has different distances for riders to choose from (30, 55, 110, 162, 390 miles). Expected attendance throughout the event is 1,400.
Riverwalk Market Fair	Bridge Square	05/20/2023-10/21/2023		\$760	Riverwalk Market Fair is an open air artisan and farmer's market. We operate at Bridge Square every Saturday Mid-May through October. Managers April and Betsy are onsite each Saturday and often our Board of Directors are also in attendance - several on the Board are also vendors/small business owners. As officers of RMF, we are both authorized to apply for this Community Event permit. Riverwalk Market Fair is a european open air market for Artists, Food Artisans, and Farmers. Vendors selling goods from tents, trucks and trailers. Entertainment, musicians, and educators will be present. This is a family friendly, rain or shine, outdoor event. Expected attendance is 250+ per hour.

We will bus students from campus and drop off in Bridge Square throughout the time frame of the event. In Bridge Square we plan to offer Tin Tea from a table under a tent. Students will then be encouraged to travel around town and enjoy the city. Expected attendance is 300 people.
Minnesota Fire Engine Club - Pumpers in the Park	Bridge Square, 5th Street and Water Street	5/27/2023		\$0	The Minnesota Fire Engine Club brings antique fire trucks to the river and pull water from the river to put on a show for the public. When it gets dark we light up the streams of water with colored lights to put on an awesome colored water show. The public also gets the chance to learn about the historical fire trucks and equipment that we use to put on the show. Expected attendance is 150 people.

June 15 date will be in conjunction with Friends of Downtown Northfield and Riverwalk Marketfair event (organizers have confirmed together). Expected attendance is 100+ people.
Pride in the Park	Central Park	6/3/2023		TBD	Northfield's 3rd annual Pride in the Park celebration will include music, activities, stage shows, guest speakers, and about 55 exhibitors and vendors who will each be assigned a space to use. Expected attendance is 2,500 people.

In the past, we have seen 20% attendance from out of town, including many participants from Rochester, Owatonna, and the metro area. It is organized by the Northfield Area Family YMCA and many community volunteers. This event was started in 2009 and has seen new families participate each year along with new families eager to participate once their children reach age 6. After missing the event due to the pandemic, volunteers, staff and participants are excited to see this community event continue after its successful return last year. Expected attendance 500 people.

There will be one stage in Bridge Square. The Vintage Band Festival was established in 2006. In this year, 2023, we will present 12 hours of music with multiple bands. It is a free festival for all ages. The bands play music from historical eras and ethnic traditions using vintage instruments. Expected attendance is 2,000 people.

The goal is a "full" rally of 28-30 airstreams camped in Ames Park Thursday through Saturday night. Rally activities are the usual thought of camping activities such as: gathering for food and fellowship, outdoor cooking, yard games, acoustic music in the evening. An "urban rally" also gives the attendees the opportunity to explore the town and support local businesses. Expected attendance at the event is 60 people.
