

ORDINANCE NO. 982

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD, MINNESOTA, OPTING-OUT OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593, BY AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 34 – LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE OF THE CITY CODE

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minn. Stat. § 462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family health care dwellings;

WHEREAS, subdivision 9 of Minn. Stat. §462.3593 allows cities to “opt out” of those regulations;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD DOES ORDAIN THAT:

Northfield City Code sections noted below are hereby amended as follows: new material is underlined; deleted material is lined out; sections which are not proposed to be amended are omitted; sections which are only proposed to be re-numbered are only set forth below as to their number and title (text is omitted).

ARTICLE 9: General Provisions

Sec. 1.13 Opt-Out Of Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593:

Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of Northfield opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Stat. §462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.
