For your lifesaving actions taken on April 22, 2016 in response to a 35 year old male suffering cardiac arrest. Upon arrival, you evaluated the victim, performed CPR, and worked with Officer Klostermeier to apply the Automated External Defibrillator (AED.) The two of you continued CPR, administered several shocks to the patient with the AED, and then assisted ambulance personnel with advanced care. By the time he was transported by ambulance, the victim had regained a heartbeat and started breathing on his own. The victim was flown to a metro hospital, later underwent surgery, and made a full recovery. He and his family are very grateful you provided excellent emergency care that revived him, allowed him to make it to the hospital, and helped him survive to return home to his family.

Your actions taken to save this young man's life merit the Northfield Police Life Saving Award.
