CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2016-097
ACCEPT 2017 TOWARD ZERO DEATHS ENFORCEMENT GRANT

WHEREAS, the Northfield Police Department is involved in traffic safety education and traffic law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 Toward Zero Deaths Enforcement Grant partners include Northfield, Faribault, and Dundas Police Departments, Rice County Sheriff's Department, and the Rice-Steele Consolidated Dispatch Center; and

WHEREAS, continued participation in combined projects like the Toward Zero Deaths Enforcement Grant allow the Northfield Police Department and partner agencies to expand traffic safety education and enforcement activities through overtime reimbursement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL THAT:

The Northfield Police Department enter into a grant agreement with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety, Office of Traffic Safety for traffic safety enforcement projects during the period from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL THAT:

The Mayor and the City Clerk are authorized to execute such agreements and amendments as are necessary for the project on behalf of the Northfield Police Department and authorize the Northfield Police to be the fiscal agent and administer the grant.
