This chart will take your HUD-designated Median Income and determine the appropriate 4-person limits. Then use those to determine the limits for 1-10 person households. (NOTE: HUD rounds their numbers up to the nearest 50 - so the numbers above may differ from HUD just slightly in some cases.)

Why does this chart not include the 30% limit?

Due to the Consolidated Appropriations Act, the definition of "Extremely Low" is more difficult to define, and is calculated based on a wider variety of figures. For that reason, the 30% line is not included above. To find the HUD-recommended definition of "Very Low (30%) Income" please refer to the HUD income limits website linked above.
