Mayor Pownell called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm.

Public Works Director/City Engineer Bennett introduced this item and representatives from the Northfield School District, Matt Hilllmann, District Superintendent and Jim Kulseth, Director of Building & Grounds, and MnDOT District 6 Traffic Engineer Michael Schweyen, District 6 Assistant Traffic Engineer David Tsang, and District 6 Transportation Planner Rhonda Allis. Thomas Sohrweide, SEH presented the TH 246 and Jefferson Parkway intersection control initial findings and answered questions posed by Council.

2. <u>17-658</u> Review of Spring Creek Flood Mitigation.

Public Works Director/City Engineer Bennett presented information and answered questions posed by Council.

3. <u>17-659</u> Discussion of City Council Rules of Business.

City Administrator Martig introduced this item and answered questions posed by Council. City Clerk Little answered questions posed by Council. Seating: C. Colby - d; C. DeLong - c; C. Nakasian - d; C. Ness - no preference; C. Peterson White - no preference; C. Zweifel - a; Mayor Pownell. No consensus. Options will be left in for vote on March 7.

Predetermined timeframe before calling the question: General consensus to remove the predetermined timeframe before a member can call the question on an item.

Call the question, super or simple majority vote: Super-6 (C. DeLong, C. Nakasian, C. Ness, C. Peterson White, C. Zweifel, Mayor Pownell); Simple -1 (C. Colby)

Establish time limits for debate on an item, super or simple majority vote: Consensus for a super majority vote.

Suspend the rules, super or simple majority vote: Consensus for a super majority vote.

C. Colby raised an objection to Rules of Decorum item 2 h regarding rhetorical questions. This item will be clarified to note that it pertains to the Council question period following the staff report.
