CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2017-008

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING SUPPORT OF FIRE STATION FACILITY UPGRADE

WHEREAS, the Northfield Area Fire and Rescue Service (NAFRS) Board recommends maintaining the fire department and the fire station facility at its current location; and

WHEREAS, the NAFRS Board recommends upgrading the current facility at a cost not to exceed \$3.5 million; and

WHEREAS, the NAFRS Board recommends that Northfield continue to own the building and lease it to NAFRS on similar terms to the existing lease; and

WHEREAS, the City of Northfield intends to bond for the entire project cost and enter collateral agreements either with the other Joint Powers Agreement Members (with each individual entity) or with the Parties (with Dundas and the Rural Fire District), to pay their portion of the cost of the project to Northfield.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THAT:

the City Council of the City of Northfield affirms its general support for the project to upgrade the current fire hall facility as presently proposed; subject to further design and development of plans and specifications and bidding documents, bidding processes, financing and related processes, and execution of such agreements and other documents as the City of Northfield deems necessary or appropriate.
