CITY OF NORTHFIELD, MINNESOTA CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2017-021 ORDERING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL A COUNCIL MEMBER AT-LARGE VACANCY ON THE COUNCIL

- WHEREAS, Council member Rhonda Pownell was elected as Mayor on November 8, 2016 and was sworn into office as Mayor on January 3, 2017; and
- WHEREAS, Northfield Charter Section 3.3 states that "a person who is sworn in as mayor while holding a council seat thereby vacates the council seat"; and
- WHEREAS, the Council passed Resolution 2017-002 declaring a vacancy to exist in this office; and
- WHEREAS, the Council passed Resolution 2017-003 appointing Gregory Colby as City Council Member At-Large to fill the vacancy through December 31, 2017; and
- WHEREAS, per City Charter, a replacement must be elected to fill this vacancy on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of this year, with the elected replacement filling the unexpired part of the term ending December 31, 2018; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 5.3, the Council must by resolution order a special election to fill this vacancy on the Council, but no primary election shall be held for this special election; and
- WHEREAS, the candidate filing period for Municipal Elections in which there is no primary held opens on August 1, 2017 and closes on August 15, 2017; and
- WHEREAS, candidates may withdraw from the election by filing an affidavit no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 17, 2017.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NORTHFIELD CITY COUNCIL THAT:

The City Council of the City of Northfield hereby orders a special election to be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017, to fill the vacancy in the office of Council Member At-Large with a term expiring December 31, 2018.
