Before the Planning/Priority Session conducted by Three Rivers Community Action, a meeting was held and the following reports were given:

- Janine Atchison conducted some research into acquiring FEMA trailers. Most are contaminated
 because they have been used for emergency housing during federal disasters. As a result, many
 are not to be used for human habitation. Information is hard to find. What about unused
 trailers? Who are the manufacturers? Must they be purchased in large lots? What is the price?
 What about having a manufactured housing business manufacture some to our specifications?
- Richard Schulte reported that the former convent at St. Dominic's is not available. The church has potential uses for the property. There is a home near the church that is for sale but the church is not in a position to purchase it. But no one knows what condition that house is in.
- Dayna Norvold reported that Lutheran Social Services are very engaged in youth homeless issues. They are willing to come to Northfield to frame the youth homeless issue. Scott Wopata has been connected with them.
- The Community Action Center (Jim Blaha) is looking at opportunities to partner with the Union of Youth and/or the Alternative Learning Center to resolve youth homelessness in Northfield.

Jenny Larson and Leah Hall from Three Rivers Community Action conducted a Priority Setting Session with the group. Their report is attached.
