








Limited Financial Assistance (hence 'seed' grant):

- Projects for energy efficiency or renewable energy
- Labor costs only for technical assistance (consultant, design professional, installer, student labor)
- \$20,000 per region (most projects get between \$2500-\$5000)
- Selected by regional steering committee







Primary Purpose:

- Encourage communitybased clean energy projects
- Spur highly visible and replicable work
- Provide a forum for community education about benefits of energy efficiency and/or renewable energy

- Notified 2nd week of Dec, 2017
- Projects start 2/1/2018
- Projects completed 2/28/2019
