- WHEREAS, the polling places designated are the polling places for the following calendar year, unless a change is made (1) pursuant to section 204B.175 or (2) because a polling place has become unavailable.

<u>Ward 2, Precinct 2</u> – Northfield Community Resource Center, 1651 Jefferson Parkway
<u>Ward 3, Precinct 1</u> – Northfield Retirement Community, 900 Cannon Valley Drive
<u>Ward 3, Precinct 2</u> - Bethel Lutheran Church, 1321 North Avenue
<u>Ward 4, Precinct 1</u> – St. John's Lutheran Church, 500 Third Street W.
Ward 4, Precinct 2 – St. Olaf College Buntrock Commons, 1520 St. Olaf Avenue
