Staff presented the concept plans from ISG, Three Rivers and those from the original Arcon Development. After reviewing the pros and cons with Three Rivers and Vern and Joan Koester, it was determined that Concept 2 was the most efficient design.

There was a discussion related to soil conditions in the area. It was noted that a Braun Intertec soils report done around 2008 showed 8 ft. of soil that needed to be corrected in or near the area where the townhomes would be built. Three Rivers received a quote from Nova Consulting Group, Inc. of approximately \$5,000 to perform additional soil testing at the site. It was determined that the testing should be done prior to the land swap.

The Koesters agreed to allow the testing to be done on their land.

A motion was made by Board Member Dee, seconded by Board Member Vohs, to proceed with soil borings on HRA propety C and Koester property B of Concept 2 with a cap of \$8,000. The motion carried by the following vote:

Northfield Union of Youth (NUY) Safe Homes Program

Staff noted the Northfield Union of Youth is faced with an annual budget shortfall of \$25,639 to fund a social worker for their Safe Homes Program. She recommended utilizing unspent funds budgeted for the 2017 Street Assessment Assistance Program.

A motion was made by Board Member Zweifel, seconded by Board Member Vohs, to direct staff to allocate \$25,639 of unspent 2017 Street Assessment Assistance funds to the Northfield Union of Youth to ensure the continuation of the Safe Homes Program. The motion carried by the following vote:
